Viktor Jakupec, ALDI Managing Director Stapylton Region has informed us that the construction of the Sandgate store is expected to be completed and open to the public sometime between July and September 2013. Demolition of the old building is currently underway. He expects construction to commence in the 3rd or 4th week of January however has made it clear

that timeframes specified may vary due to whether or for a number of other reasons.

Wayne Swan said abandoning the event was never an option "we've got our own slice of paradise here in Sandgate and it's events like the annual Australia celebrations which make it such a strong community.

"Commencing in 1997, Sandgate's annual Australia Day celebrations having been getting bigger and better as every year passes.

"Australia Day is the day we come together to celebrate community - the diversity, the comradery, our inspirational role models and what it means to be an Aussie.

"I just want to give a big thanks to Cr Newton and all the businesses and community organisations that have come on board to support this amazing event" Wayne Swan said.

Cr Newton thanked the community for their support and encouraged local businesses to come forward to donate services for the day.

"As a proud Sandgate local I'm so proud



our community can keep this event going.

"I still remember going to the celebrations back in the late 1990s, chilling out in the park while enjoying the stunning view from the park across Moreton Bay and enjoying some great music with friends to celebrate our national day.

"Since then the day has grown to include cricket games with Queensland Bulls former players, a special Citizenship Ceremony to welcome new Australians, and showcased much of our local musical talent.

"Australia Day by the Bay will continue to be a local community tradition - with great live entertainment, Billycart Racing in Cotton Street, a Citizenship Ceremony hosted by Sandgate Apex and of course the sausage sizzle cooked up by Sandgate Rotarians

"While the event will still go ahead, any further support from the community or local businesses would be very welcome."


