Sitting high on the cliffs of Shorncliffe, the Full Moon Hotel is a community icon and well renowned to 4017 residents as a natural part of our landscape.

However, have you ever considered how 'lucky' we really are to have such an amazing hotel in our local suburb? It is one of the best suburban hotels and locations in Brisbane, and with so much to offer we need to take advantage of that.

Originally, this 1860's hotel was an accommodation house to provide for local travellers. It was then named 'The Osbourne Hotel' before becoming 'The Full Moon Hotel'. The hotel is rated by NASA as having one of the best vantage points for viewing the moon.



The Full Moon is a hotel, a pub, a restaurant a function venue, a local entertainment spot and a cafe place all in one, while overlooking the seas of gorgeous Bramble Bay. Sound good so far? Well there's more. Not only does it tick all the boxes for location and services, the food is equally as important and is delicious and consistently so. (I always book a window or outside seat, as I just love it.)

The hotel is well run and it's a busy hub, offering Mothers Monday meal nights, Trivia on Thursday and entertainment on other nights. Best to call up to find out what is happening.

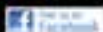

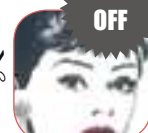
