## MCDONALDS' INTENTIONS FOR SANDGATE

McDonalds Australia representatives have confirmed they intend on lodging a development application with the Brisbane City Council in coming weeks for sites at 67-69 Rainbow Street Sandgate.

This is where the Sandgate Freemasons' Lodge and Jaguar Workshops are currently based.



Given the land is zoned for shops and restaurants, Council officers would not be able to refuse an application for McDonalds if it meets all the requirements of the MP3 zoning.

Unlike the previous application for Board Street that was rejected by Council, the application would be code assessable, and therefore no sign will be erected on the property boundaries to publicly advertise the application.

However Councillor Victoria Newton has said that she will ensure locals are made aware when Council receives the application. People can still make submissions to Council's planning teams about the application even though the application would not be subject to appeal through the Planning and Environment Court.

Cr. Newton has stated that she will be doing her best to ensure the views of the local community are considered by the development assessment officers considering the application.

# TIDES OF CHANGE

In the 1860's the Government cleared Sandgate's lower esplanade of vine scrub and ti-tree in order to open up the land from the cliff to the Pine River and allow for expansion of the settlement. This opened up sea views and access and encouraged Brisbane society to build some substantial holiday homes.


The "Brisbane Courier" of 1881 advertised – "Auctioneer's Announcement. Sandgate: 40 feet frontage to Rainbow Street, close to Railway Station - £130. 66 feet Kate Street, fenced, next to Brown's boarding house – £300. Half an Acre, fronting Sunday Street, next to Mrs Coll's – £250. 33 feet to the esplanade – £250. Also, Several Blocks at £30 per Acre; pleasantly situated with splendid views of the Ocean."

suburban sprawl began developing. Sandgate's growth became part of a general movement away from the centre of the city, an overall situation that lead to an extension of the town rate of postage from the 8-kilometre limit to 17.6 kilometres.

The bayside township had already become what it was to remain throughout the first half of the twentieth century, a mixture of highly productive farmlands, high density holiday/residential accommodation and home for commuters travelling daily, to and from their work in Brisbane

# TIDES OF CHANGE

Now there is little to show that there were ever any farms in the area. of the holiday accommodation houses were gradually converted into permanent residential flats for commuters, especially after the Second World War. many of those same buildings are being opened up and converted to single residences. Reflecting as they do the 'Old Queenslander' charm and style of architecture that kept families cool in the past and continues to do so again in the present. The seaside climate also contributed to the establishment of the Country Women's Bush Children's Home on Flinders parade between Ninth and Tenth Avenues

The original names of the avenues, as listed on the 1902 "Lilley Estate Sandgate Map" were Petty Street which became First



## PROPERTY MARKET REVIEW

ooking back at the year that was in the real estate market gives us a great insight into the areas where we have succeeded and the areas where we need to improve. In summary, sales are up but our time on market is excessive.

RP Data is reporting that the Brisbane sales volumes have risen to 19% higher than their five year average level in September 2012. This is welcome news to those vendors whose property has been sitting on the market for longer than the national average of 50 days. Compared to sales volumes in October 2011, sales activity across Brisbane is currently 45% higher.

"SOMETIMES A FRESH APPROACH IS NEEDED TO COMBAT LONGER THAN AVERAGE DAYS ON MARKET"

With Buyer inquiry and open home attendance, we have seen a gradual increase in the first home buyers as they slowly return to the housing market. The statistics (rpdata) are showing that first home buyer finance has increased by 8.9% over the past year and non-first home buyer commitments increasing by 13.2%.

Another interesting fact is the gap between

housing supply and housing demand. The latest projections from the National Housing Supply Council estimate the cumulative housing undersupply was 214,700 in June 2011, with New South Wales and Queensland having the largest supply deficiencies.

What does this mean for Sandgate? Statistics can be interpreted in a multitude of ways. Although RP Data is indicating a rise in volume of sales, the length of time a property is on the market is an indication of either an incorrect listing price or a sign of low market demand.

Using the statistics from Realestate. com.au we can see that the average day on market figure for Sandgate is 107 days (previous 6 months as at 16/01/13). This figure is well above the national average for 2012 of 50 days. An energetic and vigorous approach to marketing campaigns would improve Sandgate's excessive days on market for property.

iving and working, as a real estate agent, in the same suburb has been invaluable for research on residential mobility. One of the biggest surprises has come from the division of opinion in people with regard to how they view the suburb. Why do people have polar feelings about the very same place?

Here are some conversations with different sellers who all live in the very same suburb:

"We loved this area and that's why we've stayed here for nearly 50 years. We are the oldest in the street, everyone else has either died or moved. Now there is a lot of riff raff coming in. You just don't know the neighbours anymore. This suburb is not like it used to be." – Elderly couple moving to retirement village.

#### WHY DO PEOPLE HAVE POLAR FEELINGS ABOUT THE VERY SAME PLACE?

"This area has such a family environment with excellent schools and so safe and peaceful. Everyone is so friendly here and look after their homes. We won't move for a long time now, we love it here." – Young family with two primary school children.

"We are looking for a better life-style. This place is just too noisy and all of the old larger houses are being knocked down and two put

up in their place. It's getting over crowded and the traffic is a nightmare. Just over it now, and can't wait to move up the coast." – Middle Aged couple.

"Although this place is close to the city, it still has a real country feel about it. The sense of community here is so strong. We love going for walks and having coffees down at the local shops. I challenge you to find better."-Family with teenage children, recently purchased in the area.

Do you notice how those leaving, or planning to leave the area focus and complain about the negative aspects? It appears that they are justifying their move to each other and reinforcing their common view.

On the other hand, newly established participants to the area are experiencing a real sense of euphoria and confidence that they have chosen well. They can see only the positive and are able to overlook or ignore the so-called negative points.

Interestingly, our perception about a suburb may play a role in justifying our decision to sell out of or buy into an area. Perception of reality appears to be unique to each individual. Our feelings may be the exact opposite of another with regards to the same suburb.

### PARK RUN

Sandgate is the latest suburb to get swept up by the worldwide parkrun craze; a free five-kilometer timed run every Saturday morning in a local park, run by volunteers and open to everyone.

The Brisbane bayside suburb launched the event last November.



It's held weekly at 7am starting at Arthur Davis Park (on Flinders Parade) for runners and walkers of all ages and fitness levels.

Event director Vanessa Gibson, of Brighton, says many locals are getting on board as word spreads throughout the community.

"We're seeing over 100 runners a week on average. People love it because it offers the local community the chance to come together on a weekly basis and get physically active in a safe and friendly social environment.

"Cost is usually a massive barrier for people to participate in sport, but parkrun is completely free."

Runners register online and then print a barcode which is scanned at the end of each run and matched with the runner's finishing time. All the results are posted online by midday so runners can compare their performance with their friends and against previous times.
