SANDGATE STATION UPGRADE

The QR project team has confirmed that the upgrade of the Sandgate Station is on track for completion in mid-2013. A temporary ticket office and toilet facilities are available at the entrance to the station while upgrade works progress on the station building.

The upgrade will include a refurbished station building, ticket office and toilets, additional platform waiting shelters, passenger information display screens, and lifts and stairs to both platforms from the new footbridge. Being one of the 15th busiest stations on the network, this upgrade is very much needed.

40KM SPEED LIMIT EXTENDED

The speed limit has now been lowered along Lagoon and Hancock Streets in Sandgate to 40kmh. This is in line with the previous changes to the speed limit along the main shopping strip on Brighton Road.

Deagon Ward Councillor Victoria Newton said "with the main shopping street in Brighton Road already lowered to 40kmh it made sense to make the whole shopping village a consistent speed. This makes it clearer for motorists getting around the streets in Sandgate shopping village area, and gives pedestrians more time to see vehicles approaching.

Additionally, a new pedestrian refuge is planned for Hancock Street at Lagoon Street and should be completed by end of June.

ONE WAY ROAD TO BE REVERSED

The direction of the one-way roadway from Park Parade to Lower Moora Park will be reversed to allow safer drop-off for visitors to Lower Moora Park and the Shorncliffe Pier area.

Deagon Ward Councillor Victoria Newton said the change will enable mini-buses and coaches to use the drop-off area properly at Lower Moora Park.

"Feedback from coach operators was the current set-up wasn't working, as their passengers were getting out of the bus into the path of oncoming traffic," Cr Newton said.



ood news for the housing market, homebuyers and mortgage holders. Another rate cut was announced on the 7th of May bringing the official interest rate to a record low of 2.75 per cent. This cut should stimulate the property market, giving strength to the historically slower autumn and winter seasons.


House price growth may improve with the performance of local economies remaining the key to success. We have noticed the insufficient property on the market is starting to affect the supply and demand balance and tip it once again to favour the

seller. Enquiries have risen for the areas of Brighton, Sandgate, Shorncliffe and Deagon with more buyers seeking out suitable homes in these suburbs.

Although prices remain stable, this increase in buyer activity will aid in the lowering of days on the market statistics which are still higher than average.

The lowering of the interest rate has followed three months of rates staying steady with the last rate cut recorded in December of 0.25 per cent. Rising unemployment and the declining national income are the reasons cited by the Reserve Bank for adjusting the rate.

HAPPY 90TH DORIS MCKEERING

Sandgate RSL was the venue for the 90th birthday celebration of Sandgate resident, Doris McKeering, where she was surrounded by family, relatives & friends.

Doris Ruth Muller was born at her parents' home in Zillmere, 10 May 1923. She was the third of six daughters to Walter & Mary Muller. Walter & brother Norman had 2 butchers shops, one next to the old Sandgate Woolworths & the other, now a hairdressers in Brighton Road.

Doris attended Sandgate State School & along with her sisters often hitched a ride in their fathers Butchers wagon or walked from Zillmere now known as Taigum.

Her father passed away in 1938 having been ill for some time.

Doris started work at the Ritz Cafe Restaurant in Sandgate. Her work day started early & finished with enough time to cycle back home to Taigum before dark. For her effort she was paid the tidy sum of 5 shillings (50cents) per week.

During WW2, Mary Muller took her 6 girls by train to Ravenshoe Nth Qld where they worked on a dairy farm owned by former Sandgate residents, Arthur & Jim McKeering. Their young brother Neal often spent his holidays at the farm and formed a friendship with Doris. Her elder sister Ethel later married Jim.

Mary moved south to Wutul near Cooyar with her girls where they lived at the Thornville Hotel which was owned by Mary's parents, Otto & Maria Briskey. Doris stayed with her Uncle Walter & Aunty Elsie Briskey also at Wutul.

Neal & Doris became engaged and were married in the Sacred Heart Church in April 1943. They had 5 children Patricia, Margaret, Valerie, Brenda & Kevin.



In 1952 Neal drew a grazing property in a land ballot. It was 150kms west of Mackay & roughly halfway between Collinsville & Nebo & was named "Eastern Creek".

Doris was the cook, housewife, school teacher, the children's education being by correspondence, and any other job that came along. They spent 6 very hard years working the property for the little reward as the countryside was very poor. It is now an open cut coalmine.

The family came back to Sandgate in 1958 where Doris's present home was purchased. Neal & Doris returned to work & raising a family in suburbia. Daughter Valerie died in 1981. Doris was widowed in 1993, survived a fight with cancer & has almost lost her sight. She walks to the hairdresser Saturday mornings & occasionally the shops.

She is one tough cookie, fiercely independent and generous to a fault.

Nana McKeering has 12 grandchildren, 12 great-grandchildren & 3 great greatgrandchildren & never misses a birthday... But this one is for Doris.


