The branding and artwork for the creperie is by the very talented and local artist Rhiannan Langford. The creperie promises to offer a fresh and creative place to visit with awesome coffee. The recent acquirement of Sandgate's sushi café, has seen a rejuvenation of the shop's interior, with a bright, fresh and clean looking design. Proud owner Charlie says the entire renovation process took just two weeks from the date he purchased the Café, to opening.

After working as an engineer in Korea for a large part of his life, Charlie's dream was always to own a sushi kitchen. While his first years in Australia were spent making sushi in other's kitchens, Charlie's dream has finally been fulfilled. "The lifestyle and the time I can

now spend with my family are much more suited to me" He says.

Business is already a success, with many of his Korean-influenced sushi flavours proving a hit with locals. Among the most popular are the tuna salad, which Charlie says is unusual but delicious, and the teriyaki chicken, a classic favorite. Charlie is also extremely proud of his kitchen's 4 star Eat Safe rating, a Brisbane City Council scheme that assesses hygiene and food safety standards of food businesses. Any rating above 3 is considered extremely high.

Amidst his success, Charlie says he is very happy with his new business, and harbors hopes of opening a sushi train in a few years.

"I am a strong supporter of the work that schools and teachers do and I look forward to providing a professional tuition service to complement the work of schools and assist those children who are struggling to keep up," she said.

Take a Walk Through History

The Sandgate and District Historical Museum will celebrate Australian Heritage Week with two guided walks in the district on the Saturday 12th and Sunday 13th April 2014.

On the Saturday, participants will discover the historic homes of Sandgate. Many of the houses date back to the 1880s and the walk will include a stroll along the beach front with views of Bramble Bay and a living history of the settlement. One beautifully restored home visited will be Meridian historical home on Flinders Parade.

On Sunday, the walk will explore the historical buildings of Sandgate and early bayside history. This will be an easy flat walk which will showcase the fine architecture of local buildings and acknowledge Sandgate's early history.

Some of the buildings visited will be the now over 100 year old Sandgate Town Hall that was refurbished in 2012 and re-opened in October 2012; former Sandgate Baptist Church and the Sandgate and District Historical Museum.

Walks will be of 2 hours duration starting at 9:30am and the cost of \$20 includes morning tea.

A guide will meet walkers who have booked and who have arrived by bus or train at the Sandgate Station. Alternatively walkers can meet at the Museum at 150 Rainbow Street, Sandgate.

Similar walks will be run during the Queensland Heritage Festival with the theme 'Journeys-walking back through time' on Saturday 3rd May. During Queensland Week, walks will be held on Saturday 7th June with the theme 'home', and on Sunday 8th June with the theme 'buildings'.



Tackling Sandgate





O ver the past week we have seen some incredible fish being caught both in our local area and in the Bay.

From 116cm Thread Fin Salmon to 68cm Flathead in Cabbage Tree Creek! The Prawns are also proving a little evasive but if you have a bit of perseverance them I am sure you will get a feed.

Tailor and Squid season is just around the corner so dust off your gear, service it if needed! I think we are going to have a cracker season this year so get ready!

AIVEY &

The most commonly asked question from our clients is "I know the fish are there, I just can't catch them, what am I doing wrong?"

The usual problem is that people are fishing

with tackle that is far too big! If you want to increase your catch rate drop your Size 1 hook for Size 4 and decrease your sinker from a #4 Ball to a #1 or #2 Ball and this will allow fish to take the bait a lot easier.

You can also change your hook style, try a Tru-turn #4 Long Shank and see how much of a difference this makes to your hook up rate. Most importantly, don't over think the problem, keep it simple.

If you want to take the kids out for some fun without spending too much, try

Gar Fishing. These little guys can put on an aerial display that will keep the kids amused for hours. Go to one of the local jetties or down to Flinders Pde during high tide and cast out a Gar Rig. Seeing the smiles on the kids faces really is worth the effort!



The Bluewater Festival calendar is full of supporting events, one of which is the 'QantasLink Legends of Brisbane to Gladstone Pre-Race Party', organised and hosted by the Queensland Cruising Yacht Club (QCYC) on Saturday 12th April at 6:30pm. Everyone is invited to attend this glamorous event on the banks of Cabbage Tree Creek, with tickets costing only \$30 per person. This includes a drink on arrival, and canapés while listening to the smooth tunes of the Danny Jazz Trio.

Special Guest Speaker for the event, Maryke Barker, has long been involved with the Brisbane to Gladstone committee, and has sailed thirteen times in the Brisbane to Gladstone Yacht Race. Boating is part of our lifestyle in this corner of Queensland and with an abundance of sheltered rivers and estuaries; a boating package need not break the bank.

Open tinnie packages are the most common and these allow passengers to enjoy the warm summer sun, while adding a bimini top will shelter those with fair skin during the hotter parts of the day.

The most basic boating package consists of a tiller-steer motor, although most are now going for the side console models.

These offer more deck space, easier operation, steering like a car, and a more comfortable driving position.

Centre console boats have lost a bit of their popularity since the side console boats have hit the market.

A starter tinnie package consisting of a Stacer 359 Seasprite, a Yamaha 15hp 2-stroke, and a Redco Trailer will get you on the water, and these are relatively inexpensive.

This will allow boaties to explore the Pine River, Cabbage Tree Creek, the mouth of the Brisbane River and all other locations around Bramble Bay.

Open boats allow for ease of use and ensure that the boat remains a multi-purpose platform suitable for activities such as fishing, skiing, wakeboarding, or just generally cruising and enjoying the breathtaking scenery of Moreton Bay.

These boats allow for either tiller control engines (Steering via a handle attached directly to the motor) or side console, which incorporates a steering wheel and throttle control.

Of late, side console boats have taken over from the older style centre consoles that were popular and very commonplace during the 80's and 90's.

Bramble Bay offers much to locals as well as visitors, and there is more there than can be seen in one or two weeks, that's for sure.

I've lived in the same area my whole life and even I can't say that I have seen all the local sights, so this gives a good idea of the diversity of experiences that are available to boaties.

Northside Marine is part of the local culture and have been supplying boats to locals for more than 45-years now.




















Looking After Brighton Wetlands

Prighton is a beautiful suburb and a great place to live, and one of the main contributing factors to this is the unique corridor of preserved green space running through its core known as the Brighton Wetlands.

One group of residents who particularly value the wetlands and the native flora and fauna within it is the Brighton Wetlands Habitat Group. This dedicated group of volunteers has been getting together once a month for over twelve years to maintain the wetlands by removing rubbish and weeds, as well as undertaking various regeneration projects.

The latest project, a proposal submitted to Brisbane City Council by group coordinator Annabel Poppleton and long-time member Eddie McClymont, has seen the end of Bournewood Street, where several of the group's members live, transformed. Where once there was an overgrown, mosquito invested muddy ditch, there now exists a carefully designed filtration pond, positioned to collect stormwater run-off and attract a greater number and variety of local frog species.

The habitat group, aided with funding and earth works from the council, have cleared and landscaped the area, before filling it with strategically placed rocks and native plants. Not only does it provide the frogs and birdlife with new habitat, and keep weeds and mozzies at bay, it provides an attractive focal point for the end of the street which leads into Pimelea Woods, one of the three named sections of the wetlands.

The Brighton Wetlands Habitat Group will continue to maintain this new site, as well as previous regeneration sites in Pimelea Woods. They also plan to extend their regeneration work to a newly acquired section of Goodenia Woods in the eastern section of the wetlands. The group generally gather on the third Sunday morning of each month for approximately two hours, and always enjoy a hearty morning tea afterwards.

ANZAC DAY

nzac Day is a national day of remembrance in Australia and New Zealand, marking the anniversary of the first major military action fought by the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps, during the First World War.

Traditionally a solemn day of reflection, commemorative services are held at dawn—the time of the original landing—across Australia. Later in the day, exservicemen and women meet to take part in marches through the major cities and in many smaller community centres. Commemorative ceremonies are held at war memorials around the country.

The Sandgate Returned Services League Sub Branch coordinate the ANZAC Day Dawn Service in Sandgate at 5:50am on Friday 25th April, assembling on the beachfront nearest Flinders Parade and Third Avenue.

Surviving residents of the Sandgate district from the Army, Navy, RAAF, WWII, Korea, Malaya, Borneo, Vietnam, Iraq, East Timor and the war in Afghanistan, march from Keogh Street, along Brighton Road to the Memorial Park Cenotaph from 9:30am, commemorating all Australians and New Zealanders who served and died in all wars, conflicts, and peacekeeping operations, acknowledging the contribution and suffering of all those who have served.

Local school students and staff, members of the Police, politicians, the Cadets, Scouts, and bands with other groups and associations join the march each year, reflecting on the many different meanings of war, Sandgate State School Principal, Mr Warren Beetson says, "There is always a large contingent of our students participating each year... which demonstrates that the connection with ANZAC Day is still very relevant for our young people of today. I believe it is important for our young people to pause and reflect so that they can appreciate the sacrifices of those who fought in battles past. Understanding these things may well strengthen their resolve to defend the peace this country takes for granted."

The Sandgate RSL Sub Branch Inc. has this year moved into a new building constructed alongside the RSL Hall in Burnett Place, Sandgate. Several display cabinets shall hold memorabilia from all armed conflicts, which once complete, will be available for viewing.

Womenspace

S andgate is home to a soul space for women to connect. Womenspace, located at 2/11 Second Avenue, facilitates ongoing opportunities for women to educate and enrich themselves in a safe and supportive environment. Womenspace develops programs and runs workshops which assists women's personal growth and celebrates women's spirituality through rituals congruent with their lived experience.

With humble beginnings in early 1997, a small group of women wondered, "What if there was a place for women to share their stories? Wouldn't it be great if we could create a space just for women?" Their ideas became action, and in 1997 at their first public meeting, the founders discovered eighty other women sharing a similar dream.

Womenspace in Sandgate has been made possible thanks to the generous support of The Jani Haenke Charitable Trust, which purchased the building in late 2013 as a permanent home for Womenspace. The not-for-profit community organisation was originally based in Kedron for 10 years where the free use of a property was gifted to them. When the building became structurally unsafe, they moved out; and for the next four years, used other public spaces in North Brisbane until they moved to their current location in Sandgate.

Drop in to Womenspace on the second Wednesday of each month for 'Coffee & Chat', next held on Wednesday 9th April, 10 – 11.30am. This free gathering invites you to enjoy a cuppa and conversation with other like-minded women.

On Saturday 5th April, Womenspace will host a half day workshop called, 'The Big


