# MUSIC BY THE SEA

They look like flying saucers. They sound out of this world. And you can catch them in action when they touch down during a world tour at Sandgate Town Hall on Saturday 1st March.

All the fuss is about a new and rare instrument called the hung, or in this case three, played by Viennese musical genius Manu Delago, in collaboration with popular European bass clarinettist Christoph Auer.

Over 4 million people have seen this pioneering fusion of the world's first hang and bass clarinet duo push the limits of its instruments on YouTube.

Now, having already toured through over 20 countries, their creative project headlines as the Living Room and will give a special, one only live Brisbane performance at Music By The Sea.

Manu has rocked the stage with Icelandic singer Bjork, Shpongle, Bugge Wesseltoft, Didier Lockwood, the London Symphony Orchestra, and is currently the focus of a documentary film.

Meanwhile, record label owner Christoph studied jazz-saxophone at the University

of Graz, composes, was awarded Austrian Jazz Newcomer of the Year, and has collaborated with Miles Davis, Sting, and Vienna Art Orchestra.

After playing together in different band projects, the duo decided on this unusual musical pairing of their respective instruments, with a focus on exploring the bass clarinet's huge tonal range, and the non linear, holotrophic continuum of the hang.

Handmade by only two people worldwide, the hang is made from a special blend of metals, played on the lap or on a stand, and blurs boundaries and categories with its wide spectrum of sound and mysterious overtones.

So, if you'd like to get the 'hang' of it, the show gives a fresh take on selected original pieces, chamber music played without confinement or restrictions, and creative arrangements by artists such as the Beatles, John Cage, and Beyonce.





# **Tackle Sandgate**





Sandgate, Shorncliffe and Brighton are home to awesome fishing destinations. Whiting, Bream, Flathead are all on the menu.

A popular form of fishing for these guys is by using lures, both Hard Bodied and Plastics from Z Man Grubz to Atomic Minnows. Working the flats in front of the Swimming Pool around to the mouth of Cabbage Tree Creek are ideal locations to start your hunt. Just remember that working with lures can be a bit time consuming but once you catch your first fish it all becomes worth the effort. Be patient and try different techniques and locations.

For those that prefer to relax a little more, there is nothing better than soaking a baited line, kicking back and enjoy both the chase and the views. I prefer to get out first thing in the morning or wait until late in the afternoon to help unwind.

Some of the better baits for our area include Blue & White Baits, Preserved or Live Worms and Yabies and the humble Prawn. If you are chasing some of the larger species like Threadfin Salmon try using Live Herring or Live Mullet.

Beach areas from Brighton to Cabbage Tree Creek will produce quality fish around the High Tide period with Cabbage tree Creek fishing throughout High and Low tides. Baxters Jetty can get a bit cramped but you can explore the Creek right up to the Trawlers. The Main Boat Ramp will provide quality Bream, Flathead, Jewies and the occasional Cod.

It is important that when getting ready for your day out, remember the basics, plenty of water, a hat, sun block and a sun smart shirt, if you are on a Kayak remember to cover your legs as they will burn very quickly!

Enjoy your time with the family and "Maintain the Passion."

rtists are important because they reflect the current situation in their Art. Here we are now in the age of the individual, and artists reflect that."

Po Childs is a local character - a father, a performer, and an electrician. Known as 'The Lone Stranger', Po artistically works to inspire others, incorporating his eclectic and creative flair; driven to provide a platform for the evolving artist in us all.

First given a guitar at 11 years old in the hills of northern NSW, 30-odd years later you would be challenged to find an instrument that Po isn't willing or able play. Po says, "I think people can try everything", and his performances reflect that, in a combination of musicianship, wit, intellect and daring. His talent inspired the birth of "Organism' three years ago. Forming in mid-2011 and held at the Sandgate Scouts Hall for 18 months, 'Organism' is a network of emerging artists that gather to jam, exchange and perform their talents.

On contract, electrically wiring the 'Cardigan Bar' in Sandgate, Po and Owner/ Manager Chris Fisher built a strong partnership, and now 'Organism' comes to life again in Sandgate every Thursday evening from 7pm. Po describes the open mic night as, "...where I can season myself into the performer that I am, and I use

it as an experimental process in human relationships, developing community, networking, with the benefit and opportunity to inspire people to perform."

Described as, "a thinking person's music", Po's songs always contain a message. "They have to. Otherwise I cannot justify standing up and singing them, and putting all my energy into that. The stage is a highly intended situation."

Currently recording a twelve track CD at Clontarf's Lush Recording Studios, Po's previous releases can be bought at Ironwood Cottage and EclecTea. His latest compositions are described as, "world folk with a sprinkle of eccentricity", evolving from "tombstone, industrial folk rock". Po's earlier meditation recording 'Steel Waters', was purchased by, and is now available to borrow through BCC libraries.

As his reputation grows, Po sees the potential for local workshops, "to help emotional balance, and openness through drama as a means of actualising that." With a degree in Dramatic Arts acquired at the Queensland University of Technology, Po will draw on his education and experience, offering classes to people of all ages.

# **Brewsvegas** @ the Cardigan Bar

Prisbane is coming of age! Last year's 'Lonely Planet' guide describes
Brisbane as Australia's 'hippest city' and a star on the rise. "Sub-culture undercurrents run deep here with cool bookshops, globally-inspired restaurants and cafes, bars and band rooms aplenty."

Confirming this trend is a new Brisbane event quirkily named 'Brewsvegas'. The play on words laughs in the face of Brisbane's detractors and the term 'Brisvegas', commonly thought to have originated in jest towards our city's less cultured status during the eighties. While originally perceived as an insult, Brisbanites have reclaimed the word as an endearing soubriquet for the city, as it continues to grow in urban sophistication.

Billed as a grass roots event, 'Brewsvegas' sees the collaboration of beer bars across town including The Scratch, Archive Beer Boutique, and Sandgate's own Cardigan Bar. The week-long event is a community-minded celebration of Brisbane's burgeoning craft beer culture. The popularity of small bars in Brisbane has changed and revitalised the way we share a drink with friends. This evolution has included the service of craft beer into more venues, and exposed people to the idea that there is joy in drinking better beers, most often brewed by small, traditional and independent craft brewers.


As part of the 'Brewsvegas' celebration, the Cardigan Bar is hosting the 'Cardy Bus'; a craft beer-tasting/brewery tour, kicking off in Sandgate at 12pm, on Saturday 29th March. After the first round of drinks at the Cardigan Bar, the bus will take off for other Brisbane venues, including four
