

SANDGATE GAS WORKS

Until 1890, the first settlers in Sandgate used candles and kerosene lanterns to illuminate their tents and slab huts. Fire wood was used for heating and cooking.

In 1889, the Sandgate Colonial Gas Company Limited established a gas manufacturing plant after raising the capital of £10,000 from a public float of 2,000 shares at £5 each. The new machinery required was shipped from England, and the gas plant was constructed on three acres of land between Cabbage Tree Creek and in close proximity to the Sandgate Train Station.

The coal used to manufacture the gas was delivered in wagons by train from the Ipswich coal mines. The gas was produced in a retort (furnace) house; the stoke house was at ground level and fed by continuously hand-shoveling coal into eight ovens. Before being fully burnt, the coal was removed, doused with water, and the gas emitted was pumped into the gasometer.

In Sandgate, at this time, there were approximately 300 dwellings. Gas mains had been laid throughout the town and in February 1890 the gas was tuned on for the first time. This provided consumers with lighting and heating.



Gas lanterns attached to cast iron poles provided street lighting. A gas lamp lighter was employed for both lighting and extinguishing the lanterns. The lamp-lighter used a bicycle, and he carried a wooden ladder over his shoulder. This was a continuous job until electricity was installed in Sandgate in the 1920s.

In the 1960s, the Colonial Gas Company was taken over by the Brisbane Gas Company who sold to Boral Gas, who at that time traded as the Gas Corporation of Queensland. In the 1980s, the old stoke house at Sandgate was shut down, and gas was piped directly from the Brisbane supply at Bulwer Island. In 1997, the gas supply changed from manufactured gas to natural gas, which is piped directly from Central Queensland.

According to Justice Peter Applegarth, "In his short life, Robert Atkin contributed to the democracy we now enjoy. As the monument says, his 'rare abilities were especially devoted to the promotion of a patriotic union among his countrymen, irrespective of class or creed, combined with a loyal allegiance to the land of their adoption.'"

Robert came from County Cork, Ireland to Australia in 1864 with his wife Mary, mother Alice and sister Grace. After spending some time in Rockhampton, he settled in Brisbane. He intended to become a lawyer, but found his career leading him into journalism and politics. However, his devotion to social justice was always apparent. He campaigned against the Squatters and for the rights of the Irish and underrepresented in an English-dominated colonial system, as well as other worthy causes. In fact, it may even be Robert's contribution to social justice that led his son, the famous Lord Atkin, who all law students will recognise, into law.

Applegarth says, "Late in his life, Lord Atkin wrote about the father he never really knew, who died when he was aged only four. He wrote, 'My father must have been a man of exceptional gifts'. He pointed to the words on the Sandgate memorial. We owe it to Robert Atkin – and the values which he and his son embodied in their lives – to restore the memorial."

To date, the project has researched the Atkin history, consulted with the Brisbane City Council Heritage Unit, heritage consultants, arborists and stonemasons, as well as made connections with relations in the UK.

Community funding will be needed for the restoration and donations are being sought.

Anyone wishing to attend the Christmas Day lunch can also phone 3869 3244. The day will begin at 10.30am and include a visit from Santa.



Collectors pop the top off Sandgate's history.

Sandgate is renowned for its pivotal part in Brisbane's history, but some of its citizens are keen to twist the top off a different chapter in its past.

Some of Sandgate's lesser-known historical buildings include the many soft drink manufacturers that appeared at the turn of the 20th century to cater for the day-trippers visiting for a picnic and to holiday-makers looking for a beach escape.

With the increase in factories, came an increase in soft drink bottles of many different types and sizes, often embossed with their name and location.

Bottle collector and Sandgate local Jason Beck is part of a small yet active bottle collecting community in Queensland, with collectors coming from a range of backgrounds with different areas of interest.

"Bottles are social history," he says.

"Big history such as war memorials or town halls tell one aspect of history and are interesting, but social history tells a more intimate story about dayto-day life of times past.



"By holding a 140-year-old bottle, you can have a real sense of connection to the past."

Jason says there is a lot of Australia-wide interest in Sandgate bottles, as it was a small community with a high concentration of soft drink manufacturers.


I have been lucky enough to find some of the very early Sandgate bottles made for Henry Beard in a range various shapes and sizes," he says.

"It is also interesting to find bottles from other parts of Australia and overseas – I know other collectors have found very old bottles from as far away as France and the Channel Islands."

Jason's interest in local history began when he moved to the area 12 years ago.

"I am a collector by nature, and bottles are a tangible piece of history that you can still find," he says.

"As Sandgate has a long history of soft drink manufacturing, there are a lot of different



bottles and makers to collect.

"Being glass, bottles tend to survive while paper, wood and metal artifacts tend to decay, so they are a tangible piece of history that you can still find."

Even though Jason has a sizeable collection, he aspires to find examples of all Sandgate bottles.

"It will be a difficult task as there are lots of bottles, and some of the smaller manufactures were only in business for a short time, so their bottles are hard to find," he says.

It's a dog's life in Sandgate

It has to be said the dogs in our 4017 community have got it made from walks along the waterfront to fun off-leash dog parks in the bay. If you think that is enough to keep dog owners satisfied, then think again. Stand up paddleboard classes for dogs are now available.

Read on to find out what your four-legged canine neighbours have been getting up to down at Sandgate Beach.

The idea came about from water sport specialist Padi from Surf Connect in Sandgate. Surf Connect is a business that specialises in windsurfing, kite surfing, standup paddling, kayaking and wakeboarding.

Every year the business tries to create new programs for the school. Over the last couple of years many gym groups and yoga groups have been using the fleet of paddleboards for training. Paddling with dogs has always been on the agenda.

It was recent that Padi met June and her dog Molly walking in the park. "Molly was so cute and I instantly fell in love with her. I have actually been looking for a mascot for Surf Connect for some time, and Molly fits the role so well," says Padi.

I asked June if we could take Molly for paddling. June was a little hesitant at first, as she adopted Molly from an abusive background, and Molly would not let any male pat her. June was quite surprised when Molly did not resist me, and so I gave them a quick tuition on the SUP and Molly loved it."

It was from that moment paddling with dogs in Sandgate was conceived. The idea was

then posted on the Surf Connect Facebook page, which was very well received by the dog community. The name 'SUP Dogs' stuck and doggie paddling in Sandgate began.

Sessions are run from the Sandgate Beach for any dog under 30kg who listens to their owner. Sessions only run when it is calm, with no wind and flat water – so early mornings are best.

"We hope that through our services, we will promote health and fitness, and we can create bonding and happy moments for our local residents and their dogs," says Padi.

Third Avenue Sandgate has been selected as one of 17 streets in Brisbane to be included in a trial of LED street lighting.

The trial is being run as a joint initiative between Brisbane City Council and Energex in an effort to move towards more energy efficient streets.

It will include the use of ten different types of LED lights. These lights have the capability to decrease street light energy consumption by up to 60% city wide.

Folk legend finds his feet in Sandgate.

If you walk along

Sandgate's waterfront, you'll often see people sitting on the foreshore, staring out to Moreton Island with a guitar in hand and a melody on their lips.

To inquire about music lessons with John Munro, contact him on 0408 766 199. It's the perfect place for a singer-songwriter to find inspiration, and that's exactly what folk music legend John Munro has discovered in the Bramble Bay region.

Munro, a former member of Eric Bogle Band, which was responsible for such iconic Australian tracks as The Band Played Waltzing Matilda and No Man's Land, says in Sandgate, he has found something akin to an artist's paradise.

"I've seen some exotic places, but of course ordinary people live in those spots and they look beyond home for other exciting places," he says.

"Many, I think, would happily change places with me. I've been in Sandgate less than a year, but already I see that rare combination of village living and city access. There's a strong music and arts culture crammed into a haven of sunshine and warm social relationships. "It's hard to imagine wanting to live anywhere else."

That strong music and arts scene has inspired Munro to share his knowledge and skills, and between playing shows at Sandgate Town Hall and other venues, he plans to teach music and songwriting classes.

"I'm teaching folk guitar at beginner, intermediate and advanced level," he says.

"My philosophy, especially with beginners, is that they have to go home from their first lesson and be able to play something musical for their family. The theory is important, but it can come later.

"I'm also very keen to teach songwriting skills as a separate arm of my work. I've been lucky enough to have some of my songs recorded by overseas artists, and I'd like to encourage aspiring songwriters to express themselves to a high degree of excellence."

As for the live shows, Munro says he was blown away by the local support at his first show a few months back, which he played with his longtime musical partner Eric Bogle.

"I was quite surprised by the reception at the Sandgate concert," he says.

You're usually taken for granted in your hometown, but we had a full house, a standing ovation, and an audience that seemed to know every song.

"Seeing those appreciative faces on the night, and then running into some of the same people in the street, was a real blast."

And as for the future of Sandgate as a musical destination, Munro has high hopes.

"I think Sandgate has the potential to be a centre of excellence in Australia for acoustic music. The talent and infrastructure are here. I want to be part of that."

It's difficult to imagine a time when there is no future for Queensland, especially Brisbane and the south east corner of the state.

Things change – and Queensland is not currently a dominant state for population growth and economic performance. But, it has been in the past, and I suspect it will be again in the future. Its natural assets, its resources, its lifestyle and its climate will remain persistent attractions for businesses and residents.

Brisbane has had a solid property market over the past couple of years, without generating major price growth except in specific pockets. This relates to a lukewarm state economy, undermined by the weakness in the resources sector, and the relatively small activity in infrastructure spending.

Sandgate has been a star performer with 16.9% growth over the preceding 12 months. Median home prices jumed from \$520,000 to \$608,000. This bodes well for the adjoining suburbs of Deagon, Brighton and Shorncliffe in the lead-up to the peak spring selling season.


