

This month, Gallery 4017 at Artrageous Arts will host The 4017 Community Exhibition, now in its fifth year. Open to artists living in the 4017 area as well as those affiliated with the centre, this competition showcases the diverse art of the community's creative soul.

Artists have given the world a cornucopia of dazzling and awe-inspiring work. "Blue Poles", Machu Picchu and The Bayeux Tapestry, all still mystify viewers.

The rarefied air, in which masters and their works are held, belongs to a small percentage of artists. For most of us, our time and energy are appreciated by small circles. This is not wasted devotion. The repeated marks with a pencil or the regular flick of hook and thread can ease us into a quiet, meditative state. The challenges of life vanish, and for a while, time has no meaning. We are at our best. Shaven wood, soggy clay, tile shards and fabric shreds lay on the floor. After the mist of the trance has cleared, we see the rewards of our quiet time.

Many artists explore more than one medium or new avenues of expression. Marie Smith, winner of 2016 '4017 Annual Community Art Competition,' is one such artist. A newcomer to picture painting, she has painted most of her life as a sign writer. After lessons in acrylics, oils and watercolour, she bravely entered the 4017 Community Exhibition, with her painting, "Shorncliffe Groyne". To her delight, she was awarded the prize of a solo exhibition free of charge at Gallery 4017. With her first solo show under her belt, she will continue on her doglegged path.

Marie will no doubt be finding herself in the future surrounded by scattered pencils, and jars of brushes and, before her, a vision complete.

Should you wish to share the fruits of your meditative time with others, show your skill and vision to the community at large, then enter the 4017 Community Exhibition.

Celebrate the 200th anniversary of the bicycle this year with the Queensland Penny Farthing and Historical Cycle Club. Whether it's high tea, dance, dinner or appreciation of vintage and historical bikes, it's happening here in July.

QPFHCC Secretary, Aaron Wray says, "Pennies by the Sea is a family-friendly event, and we encourage people of all ages to come along and see these elegant machines, ask questions and even sit on a penny farthing if they dare."

Enthusiasts who built their penny through the SkillsTech course at Bracken Ridge have been inspired to create a way they can display and talk about their bicycles.

Enjoy old English folk dance with an espresso and watch the Slow Ride over 25m - the slowest wins. The penny stack is a freestanding group of penny farthings and is a crowd favourite, a wonderful opportunity to see a large number together.

A dinner is being held at Bramble Place Coffee and Tea, as well as a high tea at lunch time. "We encourage people to visit local businesses whilst in town for the event".

The bicycle, born out of necessity, has evolved from a way for people to move faster under their own power. In 1817, German inventor Karl Drais developed the Laufmaschine (running machine); a transport solution that has gone on to become today's bicycle, providing cheaper mobility, independence and freedom to millions of people around the world. There are celebrations held all over Australia and the world to commemorate this anniversary.

People coming along can expect to see the widest variety of bikes in Brisbane, including bikes harking back to early Australian history. We are a hands-on club, so encourage everyone to come along and recreate a time gone by. It'll be a memorable experience."

he passionate boat builder and Deagon Slipways owner says the Queensland Cruising Yacht Club event brings together the finest vintage yachts from all over Queensland.

The Regatta, also known as The Gaffers, will be held the weekend of July 29 and 30.

Pagan is a Tasman Seabird built in 1962 at the slipway in Deagon by Clem Masters. Peter bought the yacht 21 years ago.

"It was built to be an ocean racer, but these days it is a family cruising boat that we occasionally race," Peter says.

Each year The Gaffers at Shorncliffe sees a fleet of between 30 and 60 boats compete in four races over the two days.

( It's a really beautiful atmosphere. You still race, but it is more about the community and everyone having fun," he says.

The weekend attracts a wide variety of entries, with boats ranging in size from 10 to 60 foot.

"It's a very mixed fleet with boats ranging in value from a few thousand dollars through to millions of dollars. Even though all the boats are a bit different, they are all classic-style boats."

The regatta is very special because the people are bound by their love of all wooden boats, Peter savs.

The public is encouraged to come along and watch the fleet sail off Shorncliffe or check out the yachts up close at the Yacht Club before and after a race.

The regatta is not only open to sailing yachts; skippers of sailing dinghies, motorboats or those who would prefer not to race are also welcome to join in.

Berthing for all vessels is free throughout the weekend.

The Yacht Club will be open for breakfast and dinner during the weekend, with live music on the Saturday night.

#### EINBUNPIN BEST OF FEST BACK IN 2017

Einbunpin Festival is back on Sunday, July 30 with more entertainment, more stalls and more talented bayside locals on show.

voted with their feet last year and really supported the free activities in the Festival Arena area, so this is an area our program will focus on this year even more."

Along with the mullet tossing, tug-of-war and egg-and-spoon race at in the Festival Arena, crowds can also get in on all the food, trinkets and treats the community has to offer.

"Our local schools always put on an amazing display of cakes, jams, conserves and crafts, so you can always find gifts if there are upcoming birthdays," Cr Cassidy says.

"The festival is one of the best ways to catch up with people you haven't seen in a while because almost everyone who lives in the area attends."

Now in its 24th year, Cr Cassidy says the festival owes its strength and longevity to the fact it has remained a truly community-focused event.

"It's the time of year when our local schools, community groups, local businesses and residents come together to celebrate our community," he says.

There will be more free family fun than you can poke a stick at this year's Einbunpin Festival, with a packed line-up of activities for kids both big and small.

On Sunday, July 30, families can get involved in the shenanigans from 9am at Einbunpin Lagoon, on Brighton Road in Sandgate.

Deagon Ward Councillor Jared Cassidy says Einbunpin Festival is the "best community festival in Brisbane", and the program is brimming with brilliant events in which the whole family can take part.

"In the Festival Arena Area there will be Egg Painting, Egg and Spoon Race, Tug-of-War, Mullet Tossing, Flyzard Throw, Art Teepee, Wooden Cut Outs and the Bunpin will be dancing the Hokey Pokey with the children," he says.

The playground will be transformed into a fun-filled children's activity area with storytelling, games, singalongs, hula-hoops and Domino the Jester will be putting on a show.

"Some activities will be running all day, like the Flyzard Throwing, Wooden Cut Outs and Art Teepee. Egg Painting will be running from 9am-noon and from noon-2pm the others will be scheduled in the Arena Area.

"The Egg & Spoon races will kick off at noon, followed by the Tug-of-War and Mullet Tossing, and the Bunpin Dance will round out the session at 1.55pm."

Councillor Cassidy says there will also be plenty of prizes up for grabs.

"Each year, local businesses are generous enough to donate vouchers and goods as prize donations," he says.

"We already have a great variety of prizes including gift hampers and gift cards. We also have our world famous handmade and handpainted medallions for the winning tug-of-war team and best mullet tossers."

And Cr Cassidy says no Einbunpin would be complete without the Bunpin dance.

Following the presentation of the Colouring In Competition prizes, the Bunpin calls upon children to join him on the dance floor," he says.

The Full Moon Hotel, formerly The Osbourne Hotel, is celebrating its 150th year with a Gatsby Swing Dance Party on Saturday, August 5.

Hotel function and events co-ordinator Jenny Briggs encourages everyone to don a flapper dress or bow tie and celebrate the milestone in style alongside six-piece band Andrew Garton & his Pantheon of Swing and Charleston dancers.

It is such an honour to be a part of this wonderful celebration," Jenny says. "People in the 1920s certainly knew how to throw the party of all parties. We selected a theme to take us back in history and who knew how to party."

Originally a boarding house, Osbourne House was built in 1867 by William Cooksley and Hiram Wakefield. Not long after, the building was granted permission to hold live music and serve alcohol. "A milestone like this is something very special, not only to us but also the community. The hotel has been a part of Sandgate for 150 years," she says.

"The Sandgate Historical Society has helped us to piece together the story of the pub, and we can't wait to share this with the community."



# 'LI'L BABY CHEESES WINS WHITE CHEESE TITLE

Proving the Bay breeds champion cheesemakers, Sandgate District State High School continued its dominance in the Royal Queensland Show (Ekka) Student Made Cheese Competition by taking the white cheese title at the Brisbane Showgrounds.

The school won the Mould Ripened Cheese White category with its entry titled 'Li'l Baby Cheeses,' but their entries have made anything but a 'li'l' impression.

Sandgate has placed in the competition for the past seven years in a row, taking home two thirds, two seconds and three firsts.

Chief Judge Russell Smith said their winning camembert this year was superbly made.

"It had a beautiful creamy texture with some gorgeous earthy flavours," he said.

"It's quite phenomenal that Sandgate has consistently been in the top cheeses for seven years now and it's a testament to the school's dedication to the program."

Mr Smith, along with award-winning cheese

maker Ueli Berger from King Island Dairy, tasted their way through 183 cheeses from 30 Queensland schools this week.

Mr Berger said they were impressed with the overall quality of the kinds of cheese, with the top products commercial grade in texture and flavour.

"The students did a great job — they followed the recipe well, and the hygiene standard was very high," he said.

Many of the students will return to the Brisbane Showgrounds in August for Ekka — Queensland's largest classroom — which is now just 49 days away.

## **PLASTIC-FREE IS** IN THE BAG

A plastic bag-free Sandgate is one step closer thanks to the community initiative Boomerang Bags.

The launch of Boomerang Bags Sandgate and Surrounds this month coincides with Plastic Free July, a nationwide movement encouraging the public to make the switch from plastic, especially frequently used items like plastic bags, takeaway coffee cups and plastic cutlery.

Boomerang Bags Sandgate and Surrounds co-ordinator Lucinda Black began the community group in March with a vision of offering an alternative to plastic bags in 4017.

After hearing about the success of Boomerang Bags in other areas, Lucinda knew Sandgate would be ideal.

"I believe Sandgate has the crucial components to make this a success: a tight knit community that are all passionate about the beautiful bayside area we live in," Lucinda

Boomerang Bags are made from secondhand material and are available for free outside participating businesses. These bags offer shoppers an alternative to plastic bags and the bags then "boomerang" back for others to use.

"We hope this will change habits of the consumer and create further ripples of change through the community when they can see how easy it is to say no to plastic bags," she says.

More than 300 bags will be distributed to 4017 retailers this month. Places to pick up your Boomerang Bags locally include Cocoa Shiraz, Bottlemart, Pre Loved on 5th and Cocoabella Avenue in Sandgate, and Nathan Street Convenience Store, Brighton.

More bags will be made as demand grows, with regular working bees held at Sandgate Community Centre.

Lucinda says the true heroes in the success of this project is the crew of "Boomers" who generously give their time.

We have dozens of folk in their homes cutting fabric, ironing, pinning and sewing as we speak," she says.

## A WORD FROM OUR REPRESENTATIVES

The Lord Mayor's 2017 Council budget has now been handed down and it's a mixed bag for the Deagon Ward. I'm pleased to see over 30 streets scheduled for resurfacing this year

and funding to complete drainage works in Shorncliffe. Funding for a new Boondall Wetlands Environment Centre has also been earmarked.

Funding for local footpath and park upgrades remains in the budget. Following consultation with the community, we have been installing new playgrounds and shade cover in local parks across the Deagon Ward. Please contact me with your ideas to make our parks better.

There are however many areas that have missed out. There is no funding to improve the health of the Einbunpin Lagoon and no major investment in the long-awaited upgrade of the Brighton Foreshore once again.

I am very pleased I have also been able to secure funding for a number of local events and festivals for the year ahead. The Einbunpin Festival, Bluewater Festival, Christmas in Sandgate, Music By The Sea Festival, Sandcliffe Writers Festival, South Pacific Islander Christmas Celebrations and Zillmere Festival have all been funded in this year's budget.

## Stirling Hinchliffe MP



I'm very proud of our local sporting clubs who have pioneered women and girls in non-traditional sports. Clubs like the Hawks, Gators and Bulldogs.

However, while the growing profile of women in sport

is encouraging more participation, outdated club facilities, like change rooms, remain a large barrier for equality. The Palaszczuk Government aims to address this by introducing the 'Female Facilities Fund' as part of the 2017-18 Queensland Budget.

Over the coming weeks, I will be making contact with clubs across the Sandgate electorate to advise them they could share in \$15 million worth of funding to provide proper facilities for women under this initiative.

I also welcome the Queensland Government's ongoing commitment to our local sporting clubs. The 2017-18 Budget includes some \$44,144 as part of an \$88,287 commitment to upgrade the surface of the main playing field at the Brighton Roosters, in addition to \$50,000 as part of a \$100,000 commitment to upgrade lighting at the Brighton Bulldogs.

The advice I usually give to aspiring writers of all ages is: 'read a lot, write a lot, and (most importantly) edit a lot.' (I edit each of my books at least 20 times before it gets sent to my agent or my publisher.)

Dave's two latest books are his ninth and tenth books. Be sure to keep an eye out in September when his eleventh book – 'The Spectacular Holly-Day', will be released in the UK and Australia.
