# Opera In the Suburbs

**Local opera enthusiasts will have a rare chance to see Italian tenor Raffaele Pierno in concert this month.**

**For the first time ever, Raffaele Pierno and soprano Leslie Martin (The Nightingale) will take audiences on a two-hour journey of Italian music at the Sandgate Town Hall.**

Part of the Italian Concert Series, Primavera: Spring into Opera and Classic Italian Songs will also feature concert pianist Leanne Warne.

Raffael Pierno was born in Naples, Italy, and was singing the most demanding operatic repertoire for tenors by the age of 17. He remains a highly sought-after artist, performing at large government and charity events across Australia and the globe.

Audiences will be serenaded by the trio as they shake off winter with songs and arias including excerpts from Don Pasquale by Donizetti, La Traviata by Verdi and The Student Prince.

The concert will also include Johann Strauss's Voices of Spring and Tosti songs such as Ideale, Marechiare and La Serenata.

Raffaele and The Nightingale like to include songs an audience can sing along with, including Ciribiribin and Funiculi, Funicula.

To showcase accompanist Leanne Warne and her skill at the piano, they will perform Schubert's Impromptus and a medley of Strauss Waltzes.

Concert organisers promise an evening not to be forgotten, with traditional costumes and a gelato cart on site for a little taste of Italy.

This one-off performance is a great chance for the Sandgate community to enjoy international and national talent close by. Raffaele's busy schedule means concerts in the suburbs are very rare.

The Sandgate Town Hall concert will be held on Friday, September 8 at 7.30pm.

You can expect a range of food trucks, kids activities and of course, the Emergency and Community Services personnel and equipment to talk to. Everyone is welcome to come and explore their equipment.”

There are many displays, demonstrations and entertainment for the kids, with face painting and a scavenger hunt planned. “There will

be rescue boats, fire engines, police cars to explore and much more,” Mr Grice adds.

Brownsea Scouts will be sharing their raft building and water craft experiences for adults and children, SANDBAG will have a supply of sun-hardened vegetable and potted colour seedlings for sale, and Surf Connect’s wind and kitesurfing school invite you to try the Virtual Reality Kite Simulator, in addition to stand-up paddling and windsurfing on display.

In addition to raising awareness for safety on the water, Volunteer Marine Rescue Brisbane Inc. will also be raising funds at the Expo, held on the banks of Cabbage Tree Creek in Shorncliffe.

Mr Grice says this is a day not to be missed by the local Northside community, “Come down and have a play!”

The Expo is part of a state-wide campaign to get your home and family ready for bushfire and storm season - a great opportunity for anyone interested “to talk with the people that sometimes put their lives on the line to keep you safe when you need it most,” said Mr Grice.

“Everyone is a volunteer from our newest crew members to the President. VMR will be focusing on boating safety, to give anyone peace of mind while enjoying the Moreton Bay and surrounding waterways.”

# BIG BAND'S BACK IN THE GROOVE

**SOMETHING SPECIAL HAPPENS** when you cram 20 musos with a love for big-band grooves onto a stage, and when you add in the fact the members range from teens to retirees, it's easy to see why the New Groove Jazz Ensemble has been captivating audiences since 1996.

**D**espite its 20-year existence, the band is about to release its second album, *Back in the Groove*, and keyboard player Sacha Hughes says the launch gig at Sandgate Town Hall on September 10 is going to be something special.

"We had a huge audience there last year with the ABC broadcasting from Sandgate Town Hall, and (former ABC presenter) Spencer Howson came along and played our music on the radio," she says.

"We're looking to attract a huge crowd of jazz and big band music lovers again for our album launch, and we're really hoping to expand on the audience we have already.

"Anyone who loves huge sounds and seeing big bands in action should definitely come along and watch."

Sacha says New Groove Jazz Ensemble's second album is a cracker, but will definitely come to life in a live setting when the big band does what it does best - deliver huge jazz hits and some old-school standards in a beautiful

setting like Sandgate Town Hall. And, she says, she expects to see the dance floor in the hall packed to the brim.

"There's 20 of us in the community band, and we're really well organised now," she says,

“There's never any jostling for space as we have our roles and parts down pat, and our members range in age from teenagers to 80-somethings, so we have a really dynamic, diverse stage presence.

"There's a huge range of experience so you should definitely come along — there's even free afternoon tea. And there is a dance floor so you can definitely get up and groove along."

New Groove Jazz Ensemble launches its second album *Back in the Groove* at Sandgate Town Hall from 2pm on Sunday, September 10. Entry is \$15 at the door.

# WAR DIARY COMES TO LIFE

**Popular stand-up and character comedian, Damian Callinan, examines the horrors of war through the lens of a larrikin in his latest show to come to Sandgate.**

**C**reated to coincide with the World War One centenary, *The Lost WWI Diary* has been wowing audiences across the country for the last three years, and now you can see it at Sandgate Town Hall on September 13 thanks to Elysium Theatre.

Callinan is a multi-award-winning stand-up comic, actor and writer. He is best known for his TV roles on *Skithouse* and *Before the Game* as well as regular appearances on shows such as *Spicks and Specks* and the Melbourne Comedy Festival Gala.

Obsessed from a young age by the Anzac legend and intrigued by the mystery surrounding the identity of two diggers from a family photo, Callinan sets out on a quest to put names to the faces. Whilst holidaying in Warrnambool, the discovery of a war diary in an op shop may finally hold the answers. Callinan brings to life the pages of the diary as we meet Paddy Callinan.

He combines detailed research, hilarious but believable characterisations, black humour and clever writing to bring the story together on stage.

Elysium Theatre director Sharyn Henry says the theatre company loves to champion small-scale touring productions and she encourages others to come along for an evening of warmth and humour.

“They can expect their hearts to break and their bellies to ache from laughter,” Sharyn says. “He’s a funny guy, and I think we can all do with a good laugh.”

## *Festival Celebrates Playwright*

**Lovers of all things Shakespeare will not want to miss Shakespeare By The Bay when it returns to Sandgate for the ninth time at the end of the month.**

**T**he beloved Bard returns on September 30 and October 1 with plays, readings, talks and fun for the whole family.

Shakespeare By The Bay is part of the wider 4MBS Brisbane Shakespeare Festival running September 17 to October 1 and now in its 11th year.

Introduce your children to the Bard at the Sandgate Library with Kids Classic Shakespeare on September 30 at 11am. The free event will include Shakespeare stories adapted for the littlies, performed by local actors.

Afterwards visit the Sandgate Town Hall at noon for Shakespeare: When in Rome..., a two-hour event directed by Jan Black.

Travel back to ancient Rome for play readings of Shakespeare's classic dramas, Antony and Cleopatra and Julius Caesar. Actors from the Brisbane Shakespeare Festival troupe will perform the readings with commentary and music.

The main festivities will kick off on Sunday, October 1 at Einbunpin Lagoon Park with a spectacular Shakespearean swordplay by Prima Spada at 1.30pm.

At 2.30pm make yourself comfortable and watch the play Julius Caesar, directed by Beth Child. Based on true tales from the time of the Roman Empire, Shakespeare's classic tragedy explores persuasion and politics.

4MBS Shakespeare Festival producer Gary Thorpe says 4MBS Classic FM likes to make the great classics accessible to everyone.

“Last year was the 400th anniversary of the death of Shakespeare, and he is still the most performed playwright in the world,” Gary says.

“Since bringing the 4MBS Shakespeare Festival to Sandgate nine years ago, it has become an important part of the cultural life of many residents.

“The Kids’ Classic Shakespeare introduces children to some of the famous characters and stories in a fun way, but they are also captivated by the full production in the park.”

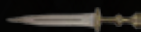

Dangerous Song

Blue by Linsey Pollak & Lizzie O'Keefe

Throughout human history, ART has served to raise individual and global consciousness by infusing awareness into the culture of the day.

With this ethical intention in mind, Linsey Pollak and Lizzie O'Keefe immerse themselves in an audio visual spectacular by renowned underwater cinematographer David Hannan, as they perform Dangerous Song — Blue.

Linsey and Lizzie work in a 3D aquarium shaped scrim where moving underwater images are projected to give the impression they're both performing underwater.

Lauded as an innovator and one of Music By The Sea's favourite artists, Linsey plays a digital wind instrument where breath, lip pressure and fingering control sounds of endangered species, by using live-looping

technology to instantaneously record layers of music.

And Lizzie joins him, weaving her voice in and out of the musical landscape of endangered animal sounds in a series of original songs.

These songs are for the planet — an inter-species choral work — and they're singing with, and for, the lives of all creatures, animal and human.

**HSST... HARK  
THE NIGHT IS VERY DARK.**

**It is one of six Australian species with the distinctive adaptation of wing-like membranes extending between the front and rear legs. While, if necessary, they will come to the ground to drink, they prefer to stay tree-bound, covering distances in the air. Impressively, this can be as far as 90 metres, using their tail as a rudder to steer. Not bad for a mammal whose body measures only 21cm. Unfortunately, not far enough to cross our ever-widening roads.**

**S**quirrel Gliders are nocturnal. They feed predominately on nectar and pollen, moving from area to area seeking out different native plants as they blossom. Other food includes gum exudates and invertebrates.

A family group often consists of one adult male, one or two females, and their young. Nests lined with leaves are made in tree hollows, which also provide shelter during the day. Breeding occurs from June to January.

Natural predators in this area include pythons, large owls and goannas. But, by far, a greater threat is the fragmentation of their habitat, and loss of food sources and nesting places.

Once extending unbroken along the length of the Cabbage Tree Creek catchment,

the local population now consists of small isolated groups: one in the Deagon Wetlands/ Third Lagoon area, one in the Tinchi Tamba Reserve, and several at Bracken Ridge. Evidence suggests isolation leads to inbreeding, weakening the viability of populations.

Brisbane City Council and other authorities have recognised the importance of installing glider crossings, but are sometimes slow to implement these measures.

From years of interest, research, and observation, Brighton resident Frank Box of the Glider Alliance has become a champion for their cause, educating the community and encouraging governments to protect and link habitats.

According to Frank, esteemed naturalist David Fleay described the Squirrel Glider as one of Australia's loveliest small animals.

**“** We live in what used to be their global stronghold and, remarkably, some still remain. Look for an opportunity to see one; they are the most delightful creatures.”

# Be Wader Aware

**Migratory shorebirds return to Moreton Bay in spring, chasing warmer months and seasonal food as they traverse the globe. Their journey is astounding. In 2007, a Bar-Tailed Godwit was tracked flying 11,680 kilometres, from Alaska to New Zealand, not once stopping for food or drink. This nine-day journey is the longest bird flight recorded.**

Godwits are one of many species of waders celebrated on September 6 - World Shorebirds Day. Wildlife advocate, Renate Hottmann-Schaefer, photographs and campaigns for bird protection.

"Shorebirds start to arrive from late August onwards. They stay in Australia throughout the summer and prepare for their epic journey to far away breeding grounds in Eastern Siberia and Alaska, from March onwards," says Renate.

The Keep Sandgate Beautiful Association invite you to meet on the foreshore on Sunday 24th and learn to be wader aware. The Deagon Ward contains some of Brisbane's most significant Ramsar sites, including the

wetlands and lagoon system out to Bramble Bay. The Sandgate - Brighton foreshore is of national and international significance because of the important role it plays in the survival of migratory waders.

"All the waders need from [us] is to be left alone," Renate says. "Try to keep a respectable distance when you are down at the foreshore. If they get disturbed frequently, they can't replenish their reserves, reducing their ability to survive on their long migration."

"Please try not to move fast when they are close-by and definitely no chasing by dogs, horses, children or anything else able to cause disturbance."

"Many species of shorebirds are in serious decline, and some could well be heading towards extinction."

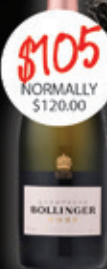

# *Eatery* THE INN THING

**There are not many views in Brisbane that match the outlook from The Shelley Inn at Shorncliffe, and now the inside is as glorious as the outside thanks to a recent renovation of the popular eatery and café.**

Owner Steven Dooley started working at The Shelley Inn when he was just 15 years old, and when the shop came up for sale seven years later, he saw a great opportunity to grow the business and make a real difference.

“After securing the shop in 2014 with a partner, my dream of transforming The Shelley Inn became one step closer,” he says.

“However, we desperately needed to renovate and revamp the shop in order for it to reach its full potential as a great family destination that overlooked some of the most beautiful scenery Brisbane has to offer.”

And renovate they did, with the changes recently completed after two years.

“The building was originally split into two: a little shop seating only a few people at the front, and storage and bedrooms in the back,” Steven says.

“The vision was to eliminate the living areas and open it all up for our customers to enjoy the extra space.

“We started by stripping the furniture and ripping up the old vinyl, revealing the original wooden floorboards.

Steven says the renovations have given the people of Shorncliffe and Brisbane a place to bring their families and enjoy fresh seafood, coffee, burgers and ice-cream by the bay.

“It was very important to me, as someone who started at the shop as a young employee, to keep the traditional values and honest service that can only be found in a local family-owned restaurant that has been in the community for over 50 years,” he says.

# SANDBAG WINS POP-UP *Café* CONTRACT

**Brisbane City Council has awarded the Sandgate and Bracken Ridge Action Group (SANDBAG) the contract for the Shorncliffe Pier Kiosk, which will feature high-quality roasted coffee, beverages, light meals and snacks.**

Council member Jared Cassidy said he suggested SANDBAG as a possible provider following broad support for a kiosk at Lower Moora Park.

"I'm thrilled that SANDBAG [has] been awarded the contract for the Shorncliffe Pier Kiosk. When this was first announced, I wrote to Council asking for a full tender process and for social enterprises to be given the opportunity to bid also.

"SANDBAG's winning tender was aimed at celebrating the history of the area, and all the profits of the business will be reinvested in the programs SANDBAG run in the community," Cr Cassidy said.

As a not-for-profit organisation, SANDBAG aims to direct any profit generated through the kiosk to support a range of programs and activities offered to people who are disadvantaged or marginalised.

"We are excited to be offered the opportunity to manage a coffee kiosk at the beautiful Sandgate foreshore, closely located to the spectacular Shorncliffe Pier," SANDBAG representatives said.

Parks, Environment and Sustainability Chairman David McLachlan said the kiosk would complement the recently rebuilt Shorncliffe Pier, creating more lifestyle and leisure activities for Sandgate.

"The proposal for a kiosk received strong support when Council surveyed local residents and businesses in Sandgate and Shorncliffe, with an overwhelming 84 percent of responses keen to see the kiosk built."

“ Council recently completed a \$20 million renewal of the iconic Shorncliffe Pier, and at the time, committed to further activating the precinct with a pop-up café," Cr McLachlan said.

Cr McLachlan said the new kiosk would complement Council's \$590,000 investment to enhance the Sandgate foreshore, and that the Shorncliffe Pier was one of Brisbane's most loved and historically significant landmarks.

"Projects like the new kiosk at Shorncliffe help create a vibrant, liveable Brisbane that provides more lifestyle and leisure opportunities, with better facilities and venues for all ages to enjoy."

# SUSTAINING GREEN LANE

**The Sandgate State School community pride themselves on looking to the future; addressing sustainability and well-being.**

Combined school and P&C funds of \$6,500 have been donated towards maintaining the perpetuity of edible gardens on-site, first established within the area known as Green Lane, in 2010.

Green Lane sits between the school tuck shop and prep rooms, engaging the whole school. Former parent and garden volunteer, Leanne Abbey explains, “Our idea was to have an area to admire, to linger, to work in, to rejoice; any time of the day for everyone, to bring the school community together.”

“Green Lane has focused on education and involvement for our children on where their food comes from, since 2010. To move with this vision, we are embarking on a new exciting project,” Principal Warren Beetson says.

“The green space is to be transformed into an orchard within a series of garden beds. Our aim is to provide a safe space of learning for children at Garden Club, and to reduce food waste in our school through composting and water efficiency.”

Nine new raised, no-dig wicking beds will be built using untreated hardwood. The Garden Club will plant low-maintenance, high-yield plants requiring minimal care.

Parent-volunteer, Kelly Williamson says, “We intend to keep our parents in supply of healthy fresh produce every week. We will donate fresh food to our tuck shop so that all children in our school can benefit from homegrown, spray free, organic produce.”

Kelly has, “lost count on how many parents say to me that their children are now eating things at home that they never would have in the past, after having that experience of growing their own food.

“The children feel a great sense of pride in their garden space, and it teaches them valuable skills on working as a team.”

The focus on low maintenance, self-watering systems and sustainability will make gardening a breeze for the school community.

## FRESH FOCUS FOR GARDEN GATE NURSERY

**For all green fingered community members, or those wanting to become one, here is another reason you don't need to venture far from 4017. The Garden Gate Nursery in Sandgate has a new Nursery Coordinator who has brought her enthusiasm and passion to the centre, and she's ready to impart her abundant knowledge on backyard sustainable gardening.**

**T**he Garden Gate's new focus is to make a community space to educate, grow and share all things backyard.

Workshops will be held on how you can become self-reliant within just a small space. A variety of edible fruit trees, herbs and vegetable plants will also be for sale.

For Nursery Coordinator Anne Donohue, gardening has always been a big part of her life having an interest since childhood, "Coming from a heritage of farmers and gardeners, gardening was in the blood," says Anne.

Anne has been a tropical and sub-tropical gardener most of her life and has a background in natural alternative medicine, initially, her special interest was growing herbs mainly for medicinal and culinary purposes.

During the early 80s, Anne did a landscape design course and spent a lot of time developing the home garden with aesthetic design being her primary objective. After moving to semi-rural acreage in South East Queensland, she focused more on a self-reliant and sustainable lifestyle. Her gardening then took on the principles of permaculture design.

A lot of inspiration for her garden has come from travelling, visiting farms and gardens across Australia and overseas.

"By growing your own food, you are reducing your carbon footprint and experiencing the joy of producing your own food. You get to enjoy the different tastes, the quality of fresh food and you reconnect with nature," says Anne.

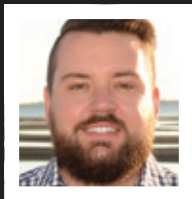

4017 locals urged to stay alert for swooping magpies.

Like most Australians, I have some very distinct memories of being swooped by magpies during the spring months. As we enter September, I want to remind

all residents across the 4017 and surrounding suburbs to be aware of swooping magpies and to take the necessary precautions to ensure you stay safe during magpie 'swooping season'.

Although studies have shown that less than 10 percent of magpies are aggressive towards humans, I want to remind people there are a number of ways to protect yourselves from a swooping magpie.

Broad-brimmed hats and umbrellas are great ways for pedestrians to protect their heads and faces, and cyclists are encouraged to dismount their bikes and walk if they are being swooped.

While a magpie swooping is mostly instinctive, it is important to not "fight back" because it could further aggravate the magpie. Remember, because they are a protected species in Queensland, any interference or unpermitted relocation is prohibited.

If a magpie that is defending its nest becomes aggressive and a risk to human safety, it may be removed by contacting the Department of Environment and Heritage Protection.

Jim Murdoch is the club's number one supporter and says the introduction of the Murdoch Mile Trophy encourages club swimmers to test themselves over the long distance while maintaining a sense of tradition.

"In the 1950s, I learnt to swim at the Sandgate Swim Club and continued swimming with the club at weekly club meets and representative events until 1966," he says.

"I originally swam the mile in the old saltwater pool, which was located off the rock wall near the end of Fourth Avenue and although the records for that era have been lost, I clearly remember being awarded the winner's pennant for the Open Mile in the 1964/ 65 season."

## FROM THE ARCHIVES

# THOMAS DOWSE, PART 1

*Dowse Lagoon is a well known landmark in the centre of Sandgate. It's namesake, Thomas Dowse, was one of the first European settlers to the local area, settling here with his wife and family in 1842.*

**Thomas Dowse has the honour of being Brisbane's first public relations officer, consistently extolling the advantages and great potential of living in the Moreton Bay area. Described as a 'quiet achiever', he fulfilled many roles such as errand boy, auctioneer, importer, shipping agent, wharfinger, merchant, a newspaper correspondent, and real estate agent.**

However, he is probably best known for writing one of the earliest histories of Queensland. Despite all of this, his death certificate lists his occupation simply as 'Gentleman'.

Dowse led an interesting and accomplished life. He was one of five children to William Dowse and his wife Catherine (nee Barren), born on 12th January 1809, at Hackney, London. In September 1824, at the age of 15, he was tried in the Old Bailey for stealing, on 16th August at St. Andrew, Holborn, a

coat, value 2l, a waistcoat, value 5s, a pair of trousers, value 10s, a handkerchief, value 4s, and a shirt, value 4 s which he went on to pawn for 35 shillings. Because of his youth, he spent four years imprisoned on a convict hulk "Bellerophor" on the Thames before he was shipped to Australia on the "Florentina", in 1828.

Finally, in 1840, he was granted a conditional pardon and was free to travel outside the district of Sydney. Thomas, his wife Anne, and their two sons decided to make their way to Moreton Bay which was opened to free settlers in 1842. They arrived on 20th July on the "Falcon" and settled under canvas, on the southside of Brisbane, beneath a gum tree.

It was from this time that Dowse began to use his initiative and skills to make his mark on Brisbane.

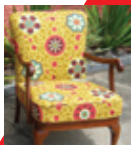
