The Best of British ROCK UNDER THE CLOCK

There will be a 'British Invasion' on Sandgate later this month as Best of British Rock... Under The Clock transforms the historic Sandgate Town Hall on May 26.

The popular bi-annual Rock Under The Clock event will have live entertainment provided by local legends Jim Hansen & The Sonics (dressed in Union Jack costume), with Nicky Steel as guest artist.

The Sonics guitarist and event organiser Rod Kippen says to add to the British atmosphere they are hoping to have a 1960s London double-decker bus on site to use for photographs.

Rod says the Rock Under The Clock evening will feature the 'British Invasion' music that overtook the world's hit charts during the 60s.

// There'll be music from artists such as The Rolling Stones, The Beatles, Herman's Hermits, Gerry & the Pacemakers, Dave Clark Five, Dusty Springfield, Lulu, Petula Clark and so on," Rod says.

"Each event carries a feature theme to underpin the entertainment on the night, which revolves around 60s popular music.

"This usually transitions to generate a nostalgic experience for the dancegoers who continue to be overwhelmed in their praise for a great night out."

The dance fundraiser, held since 2015, gets its title from the iconic rock tune Rock Around the Clock, which featured in the late 50s movie Blackboard Jungle.

To complement the music entertainment, the ambience of the Town Hall will be transformed into

all things British — from Union Jack bunting, to London Underground signage, to Battle of Britain Lager and pork pies served for supper.

The evening will kick off with Rule Britannia played with cannon and musket sound effects and during interval and supper, trivia themed on 60s British music will keep the theme alive.

The Sonics have been playing gigs at the Sandgate Town Hall for more than 50 years and have formed a strong bond with the venue.

"It's truly a fun experience that takes you back to your teenage years (if you are now in your late 60s) and great value for money," Rod says.

Proceeds from the event go to the Sandgate PCYC. More than \$30,000 has been raised since the fundraiser began in 2015.

Bookings are essential and can be made through trybooking.com/hect. Prices for the dance floor are \$49 and include a light supper and refreshments.



CR CASSIDY LOBBIES FOR BRIGHTON FORESHORE UPGRADE

Deagon Ward Councillor Jared Cassidy is calling on all residents to help raise awareness for the long-awaited Brighton foreshore upgrade. Cr Cassidy has started a petition asking Brisbane City Council to re-allocate funding that was diverted as a result of the 2011 Queensland floods.

"The project was planned, and funding was allocated right up until 2010-11, but the 2011 flood repairs required funding, and various Council projects were delayed to complete recovery works. The Brighton foreshore upgrade was one of these projects.

"However, with [floor repair] projects well and truly complete, we still haven't seen that funding returned," Cr Cassidy said.

Cr Cassidy believes that the foreshore upgrade will require more than the initial \$3 million allocated, considering that almost a decade has passed since the original plans were developed in 2005.

"My vision for the Brighton foreshore upgrade would be to first make the area more usable and safe including wider paths, upgraded lighting and railings, and more facilities and other upgrades to really capitalise on its unique position as one of just two areas in the entire city of Brisbane where people

can really connect with Moreton Bay (the other area being the Wynnum Foreshore)," Cr Cassidy said.

"The beach area near Nineteenth Avenue is very popular and shows it could become a hub for families, water sports enthusiasts and visitors enjoying direct access to our magnificent bay.

"Toilets are also essential, and there are none between the Sandgate Pool and Decker Park," he said.

Cr Cassidy said the benefits of the upgrade would be far-reaching.

"The first and biggest benefit will be to local residents in Brighton and surrounding suburbs. It will become an area that we will all be proud of and will add so much to our enviable lifestyle here in the northern suburbs.

"The benefits will, of course, be felt much more widely than just in Brighton. The foreshore is there for the benefit of all Brisbane residents. I want to see people who head to Southbank or Redcliffe, consider heading to Brighton, Sandgate and Shorncliffe instead.

► June: Eric Bogle - Australian troubadour

Australia's international music troubadour Eric Bogle returns to Music By The Sea in June to perform a concert of moving songs ranging from melodic ballads to comedy and stinging satire, penned in the unique style that has won him accolades around the world.

Bogle is well established as a contemporary folk singer who also explores other genres. He's famous for covering themes like the futility of war with songs like *And the Band Played Waltzing Matilda*, and *No Man's Land*, also known as *The Green Fields of France*.

An example of the strength of his influence is 'And the Band Played Waltzing Matilda' that was written in 1971 and has since been recorded by over 100 artists ranging from Joan Baez to The Pogues.

Some years later the Fury Brothers and Davey Arthur recorded *The Green Fields of France*. The song was so popular it spent ten weeks at No. 1, with a total of 26 weeks in the Irish charts.

And it seems they weren't the only musicians who recognised the massive appeal of his work. At least 50 of Bogle's songs were recorded by the likes of Billy Bragg, Donovan, Mary Black, The Dubliners, Slim Dusty, John Williamson and others.

On a lighter note, one of his comedic songs is titled *The Aussie BBQ*, while *Little Gomez* and *Nobody's Moggy*

Now have great appeal for both animal lovers and humourists, and for legions of music fans, there's *Do You Sing Any Dylan?*

Born and raised in Scotland, Bogle is now lauded as an Aussie national treasure with accolades that include a United Nations Peace Medal, Member of the Order of Australia, a Gold Disc for APRA Song of the Year, 17 studio albums, eight live albums and nine anthologies.

So, there's quite a pool of material to draw from during the Sandgate performance. And the question has been asked, "What's the setlist?" Well, apparently there isn't one. Bogle says he doesn't use them. Instead, he gages what the audience will enjoy and responds with the magic of the night.



Gold fever has hit Sandgate with a local resident the proud recipient of a Commonwealth Games gold medal.

Long time member of the Brighton Bowls Club, Tony Bonnell (pictured centre above), represented Australia in the Bowlers With A Disability Men's Triples lawn bowls event, clinching gold over Scotland in the final.

Tony says it was a once in a lifetime experience and one he will never forget.

"Winning the gold medal is a moment I will celebrate forever and to do it in my own backyard is something that can never be replicated," he says.

"A Commonwealth Games at home is different because everyone gets to experience it, not just the athlete and their immediate family, but their extended family, club, community and the entire nation.

Tony has a long history in competitive bowling lasting over 20 years and has been competing in disability bowls for almost a decade.

"I am an above knee amputee due to osteogenic sarcoma when I was a teenager," he says.

"Being an athlete before I lost my leg, I found bowls soon afterwards to maintain that competitive streak.

"I was selected to compete at the Glasgow Commonwealth Games in 2014, but my team didn't

win our section so we didn't qualify for finals.

"At the Gold Coast games we played all of the other five countries (South Africa, New Zealand, Scotland, Wales and England), finishing on the top of the ladder and qualifying to play and win against South Africa in the semi finals.

"We played New Zealand in the gold medal match and won on the last end - it is my greatest sporting achievement."

Tony says his home bowls club and the local community have been incredibly supportive of his sporting journey over the years.

"Brighton has provided me with fond memories and good times over the past couple of years during my prep for the games and other competitions, as well as being a social support to me and my family," he says.

"My family and a number of the club members came to my events during the Commonwealth Games and it was great to have their support and hear them cheering my name.

"Everyone was so excited during the gold medal match and those who couldn't attend watched the game at the club - it's exciting not just for me and my family, but also for my bowling family.

"To hear them yell and support any good bowls that I put down will always be a favourite moment to cherish."



FROM THE WOMB TO THE WORLD

Every second counts in this world, and Dr Susan Walker knows that the earliest moments in our lives are some of the most important. Dr Walker is a chiropractor who has mastered applied kinesiology and is a founding member and practitioner of the Retained Neonatal Reflexes Technique, a method of treating children with learning difficulties and behavioural problems.

"The very beginning of the wiring of our brain forms our neurological template for how we are going to structure our movements and how we are going to see the world," Susan said. "Some of these reflexes are expressed during birthing and delivery, and others after the first few months of life. Academic and author, Dr Daryl McPhee

OUR BELOVED BAY EXPLORED

Story *Philip Woods*

Dr Daryl McPhee is an esteemed academic, a published author, and a renowned authority on the ecology of our Moreton Bay area.

He first visited our region in 1985 as a fourteen-year-old boy, an experience that Daryl describes in his recently released book, 'Environmental History and Ecology of Moreton Bay'.

"Having just moved from Sydney to Brisbane and staying at a hostel for the homeless at Indooroopilly, I caught the train to Shorncliffe and saw Moreton Bay for the first time. That day changed my life. That is Moreton Bay."

Daryl went to Sandgate District High School and spent his formative years in Shorncliffe before studying at The University of Queensland where he obtained a PhD in Biology. He still visits the area several times a year. Daryl described what it was about Moreton Bay that has maintained his attraction and interest over the years.


"It's the bay's natural beauty and its diversity. It's not like anything else on the east coast," Daryl said.

"It's a mixing area for both tropical and temperate species. It's the southern-most limit for coral, for dugong and for humpbacks, and it's also a home to temperate species like tailor, which migrate through from temperate waters. It has great diversity."

Daryl is currently Head of Higher Degree Research at Bond University and Director of the Commonwealth Government's Fisheries Research and Development Corporation, and he will be presenting a talk on May 27 at the SANDBAG Community Centre in Rainbow Street entitled 'Sandgate and Beyond — The Environmental History and Ecology of Moreton Bay'.

Although he works in a world of academia, Daryl still finds great satisfaction in sharing his knowledge with the general public. "In my mind, scientific and technical information shouldn't just be kept 'in-house', it should be extended to be available to the public," Daryl says. "We should be doing work that's meaningful to the public, and it should be able to pass the pub-test in my opinion".

If you have an interest in the ecology of our beloved bay, then don't miss Daryl's talk at SANDBAG on Sunday, May 27 from 2pm.



ROAD WORKS UPDATE

The Gateway Upgrade North Project involves upgrading the Gateway Motorway to six lanes between Nudgee and Deagon. Construction kicked off in February 2016 and is set to be complete late this year. Motorists are advised to keep a close eye on traffic changes in the area.

The Sandgate Road northbound onramp to the motorway will close in mid-2018. To ensure connectivity to Redcliffe and the Gateway Motorway is maintained, the closure of the on-ramp will coincide with other key traffic changes in the area, including the opening of the Deagon Deviation northbound lanes. More information about the Sandgate Road on-ramp closure will be available in the coming months.

Travelling north from Sandgate Road:

1. Sandgate Road to Gateway Motorway/Bruce Highway: access via the Depot Road on-ramp (instead of the current Sandgate Road northbound on-ramp, which will be closed)
2. Sandgate Road to Redcliffe: continue onto the Deagon Deviation via the upgraded Depot Road/

Braun Street intersection to access Redcliffe without needing to use the motorway (instead of the current Sandgate Road northbound on-ramp, which will be closed)

Local roads update

Barfoot-Bracken Ridge Rd intersection works, Bracken Ridge: Work is underway to upgrade the Bracken Ridge Road and Barfoot Street intersection, including modifying the southbound motorway off-ramp to Bracken Ridge Road. The upgrade of this intersection involves replacing the roundabout with traffic lights. The adjoining southbound off-ramp will be improved to allow more space for queuing vehicles as they approach the intersection. These works are expected to be completed in mid-2018.

Depot Road/Braun Street/Board Street, Deagon: Work is also progressing well to widen Depot Road from two lanes to four lanes between Braun Street and the Gateway Motorway onramps at Depot Road. This includes upgrading the intersection at the Depot Road/Braun Street/Board Street/Deagon Deviation. Works will continue until mid-2018.




