

inbunpin Festival 2018 is almost here, and the whole community is busy preparing for Sandgate's biggest showcase. Back for its 24th year, this year's festival promises all the usual favourites as well as some new entertainment, sure to make for the best celebration yet.

Deagon Ward Councillor Jared Cassidy says this year's theme is "Celebrating Our Community" and local schools, community groups, businesses and residents have spent hours preparing their stall or act.

This year, more than 160 stalls will be joined by festival first timers Queensland Penny Farthing and Historical Cycle Club (Pennies by the Sea) and the Queensland Association of Quidditch.

"There are a few new exciting additions to this year's festival," Cr Cassidy said.

"Pennies by the Sea will be joining us for the first time this year... to join in the Einbunpin fun."

The Pennies will hold their Tweed Ride on the morning of the festival and will finish within the festival arena. They will be holding an information stall and forming their famous Penny Stack later in the day. Visitors will also be welcome to take a photo with a Penny Farthing.

The Queensland Association of Quidditch will be conducting "Kidditch" workshops.



The workshops will teach children the art of Quidditch and will take place in the festival arena from 12.40pm to 1.25pm.

"This is sure to excite all those Harry Potter fans within our community," Cr Cassidy says.

Cr Cassidy encourages everyone to come along and soak up the village atmosphere of the festival on Sunday, July 29.

The Einbunpin Festival is one of the best ways to catch up with people you haven't seen in a while because almost everyone who lives in the area attends," he says.

"Whether you take time to listen to some of the local musicians on one of the four stages, check out the community artworks at the Bridge Gallery or pick up some delicious jams, cakes or crafts from one of the stalls, the day is sure to be a fun one."

### TALENTED TRIO TAKES THE STAGE

inbunpin Festival visitors will be treated to the sounds of Celtic and Australian folk music thanks to talented local trio Little Sparrow. Little Sparrow was formed in 2017 by band members Katie Lawton (vocals, fiddle), Maxine McCabe (vocals, guitar) and Jenni Lake (vocals, flute, double bass).

The experienced musicians had been playing together in another local originals band, Violets in Damascus, when they decided to start the folk trio.

"We had been talking for some time about how we would all love to start playing Celtic music and learn more about our various ancestral backgrounds, when David O'Keeffe, the conductor of the Queensland Irish Choir, asked us to play for the choir for their September concert last year," Katie says.

"It was too good a chance to pass up, so we got together and started working on some of our favourite Celtic tunes.

"We have seriously loved working on this music together and building our three-part vocal harmonies and instrumental arrangements."

Since forming, they have performed at The German Club, and more locally at the Cardigan Bar

They decided Einbunpin Festival would be the perfect next stop to share their love of folk music with the community.

"We would love to play a small part in celebrating our local community, which we think is pretty special and unique," Katie says.

Audiences can expect a mix of traditional and original tunes, played on fiddle (Katie) whistle, flute, double bass (Jenni), guitar and banjo (Maxine), with vocal harmonies (plus the odd kitchen utensil).

These three talented women live and breathe music as well as juggling day jobs.

We all have a Celtic background and have all been wanting to explore the music, the stories and the history of Celtic culture in Australia for a long time," Katie says.

They continue to share their love of folk music at Sandgate Folk Jams held at SANDBAG once a month on a Saturday afternoon.

"All instruments, voices, ages and abilities are welcome. We will be playing a variety of different styles of music from Celtic to Australian bush tunes to Bluegrass."

rtists of the 4017 and beyond are sharpening their pencils and cleaning their brushes in anticipation of the annual Artrageous community exhibition.

The competition, now in its sixth year, opens on July 13 and calls are currently being made for entries.

Artrageous resident artist Shane Rodwell said the competition had expanded.

"Originally it was just for artists who lived in the 4017 postcode, but we have expanded it to include artists who are affiliated with the Artrageous community arts centre," he said.

"We find the competition is a great way to engage with the community, and also to nurture emerging artists. And it's a way for people who have a passion for art to climb up another rung on the ladder "

The judge for this year's competition is Christine Atkins. Christine paints in oil and is also a notable pastel artist. Her work includes lino prints, pen and ink and charcoal drawings. Christine has won numerous awards for her paintings, and her work has been published in many artists' books and magazines.

"This is a really accessible competition, for artists and the community," Shane said.

We do have a lot of professional artists who enter, and there are those who enter who may not make a living from art, but they're passionate about it."

The winner of the competition receives a solo exhibition of their work at Gallery 4017 in Loftus Street, Deagon, which will be held in June next

Last year's winner Marietta Hanaghan currently has her exhibition of watercolours titled 'Water. Logged' on show.

"The competition is also a fundraiser," Shane said.

"We are a not-for-profit, non-funded organisation and, as far as I know, we are the only artistic organisation like it in Australia."

Entries in the Community 4017 Exhibition must be delivered to the gallery at 82-88 Loftus Street, Deagon by 3pm on Tuesday, July 10.

The winner will be announced on opening night, on Friday, July 13 at 6.30pm. Members of the public are also invited to attend opening night.

Even though they hail from other places there's a special connection that Lisa Stewart (violin), Myee Clohessy (violin), Stefan Duwe (viola) and Anna Martin-Scrase (cello) have developed over the years with the Music By The Sea audience.

Perhaps it's partly due to the fact that Myee has loved and respected family here — and then there's this special quality they've developed over the years performing together that really invites people into their music.

Never-the-less, over the last seven years, Acacia has garnered respect near and far for their new and interesting sound, their support of Aussie composers and young musicians, and their joy of sharing a love of the art with young and old.

This fresh approach has recently spun-off into an international debut in Vancover, Canada, and concerts in Berlin, along with a CD recording of work by German composer Gunter Raphael.

Wonder if they listened to their own music on the Qantas in-flight entertainment?

Speaking of which, their most recent ABC Classics recording 'I Was Flying' with ARIA award-winning pianist and composer Sally Whitewell reached no. 2 on the Classical iTunes Top 100 Chart, and then became an ARIA finalist.

Meanwhile, back to earth and down by the bay, the local program brilliantly showcases works by Osvaldo Golijov, Gordon Kerry, and Antonin Dvorak.

Let's have a brief squiz at the themes; there's violence and beauty in a haunting piece titled 'Tenebrae' by Golijov.

Aussie composer Kerry offers his new 'String Quartet No. 5', featuring hymns and musical descriptions of nature.

And then there's the famous 'String Quartet No. 12, Op.96, American' by Dvorak that draws on African-American flavours.



Following a preliminary planning meeting with Duncan Austin of Brisbane developer Hardev Property, BCC has agreed to consider the proposed development application for a service station and multiple dwelling, which will be built on a re-configuration of lots 397 and 399 Bracken Ridge Road.

The DA will include the provision of a drive-through food and drink outlet and a townhouse complex, planned for construction adjacent to the service station.

The development will require the extension of Norris Road past the intersection of Bracken Ridge Road to the north.

Approximately 200 metres of new road will be constructed to service three proposed new lots across the 1.73hectare site.

No detail has been provided as yet regarding the style or number of townhouses that will be built, but they will be adjoining the Gateway Arterial Road at the rear, separated by a proposed acoustic sound barrier.

Hardev Property has been responsible for numerous developments across south-east Queensland in recent decades, including 'The Village' retirement villages in Taigum, Redcliffe and other locations.

ee the sights from the shore or bring your boat to the bay in July, as the Queensland Cruising Yacht Club hosts its annual Vintage Yacht Regatta on the weekend of the 28th and 29th July in Shorncliffe.

"The best thing to do would be to come down for breakfast. We open up the marina, and anyone can just come down, walk around on the marina and have a look at the boats."

The club is expecting this year's Vintage Regatta weekend to be as popular as ever, providing a highlight for boaties and spectators alike. Seeing this many vintage vessels together in one place will certainly be a feast for the eyes.



# Big Splash In the Making:

### Sandgate Aquatic Centre Upgrade Underway

ord Mayor Graham Quirk said works are now underway at the Sandgate Aquatic Centre for a new, 25-metre indoor heated pool and gym, improved access, car parking and an upgrade to the kiosk and canteen areas. Brisbane City Council announced the upgrade would transform the Centre into a contemporary, all-season leisure facility.

"Brisbane is a great place to live, work and relax, and Council is committed to creating, even more, to see and do, with upgrades to pools and community facilities across the city," Cr Quirk said.

Council says the upgrade will focus on improving the pool's facilities and accessibility while keeping with the look-and-feel of the Sandgate Foreshore.

"The new pool will feature a ramp, making it accessible for visitors of all abilities, and will be

available for a range of classes, including learn to swim and aqua aerobics," Cr. Quirk said.

Plans also include extending the car park to include spaces for people with disabilities and improving toilet and dressing room amenities.

Our pools are not only worldclass recreational facilities but provide family-friendly lifestyle and leisure opportunities for swim development, local events and weekend activities," Cr. Quirk said.

Throughout construction, residents in the immediate surrounding area may experience increased noise from construction activities, which will take place from 6.30am-6.30pm, Monday to Saturday. Council says it will make every effort to minimise disruption to the local community during this work.

When the Centre reopens for the summer season on September 22, 2018, the 50-metre pool and aqua play area are expected to be fully operational. Weather permitting, construction for the new pool, gym and upgrades are expected to be complete by late 2019.

"The Sandgate Aquatic Centre is visited by 70,000 visitors each year, and we are investing in this facility to ensure it remains a great community facility for many years to come," Cr. Quirk said.

# Pennies By The Sea Sandgate's Wheel Big Deal

touch of 1800s nostalgia will delight Sandgate locals this month with the ninth annual Pennies By The Sea. Themed around the historic penny farthing bicycle, the event attracts curious visitors as well as penny farthing enthusiasts.

Run by the Queensland Penny Farthing and Historical Cycle Club (QPFAHCC), the afternoon will feature a full program of parades, displays, races and entertainment, with this year's highlight the introduction of a variety of turtle races.

QPFAHCC president Aaron Wray says the turtle race is an old and timeless institution and is often referred to as a slow race.

"We called it a turtle race because turtles are iconic across Queensland," he says.


"It's a ride of skill and ability rather than speed, favouring those with excellent bike control.

The rules are simple — you set up a course with between two and four lanes, and participants have to move forward at all times over the 25 metres, without leaving the lane or putting a foot or any part of their body down.

"It's quite exciting for the audience to see people sitting almost at head height wobbling and trying to stay upright — when people overbalance the resulting tumble is slow but spectacular."

If turtle races are too slow for your taste, there are plenty of other sights to see.

"Visitors can get their photo taken on a penny farthing for a gold coin donation, and we will have displays of a variety of old bikes including



shearer's bikes and other unique bicycles," Aaron says.

"It is a great chance to get up close and personal with 130-year-old bicycles, sit on them and feel the history.

"It is also great to ask questions and learn about the history of bicycles."

Aaron says it is important to involve the community in the occasion as it reminds people of the long history of Sandgate.

"Sandgate is a very supportive community, and we've tried to use local vendors and suppliers wherever possible," he says.

"We also have fantastic support from local members Jared Cassidy and Stirling Hinchliffe who have been right behind us from the beginning."

# Rescued Roo Re-Homed

Recently rescued from a minor misadventure, a young male kangaroo has been safely relocated to Tinchi Tamba Wetlands near Brighton.

Therese Hollan of the Brighton Kangaroos 4017 Facebook page says there are many kangaroos living in these areas and that it's good to be aware of them. "There's quite a few mobs in Tinchi Tamba," Therese says.

The little guy's trouble started when he took a wrong turn near Lover's Walk at Sandgate, to wind up in the chilly waters of Moreton Bay! After rescuers pulled him from the water, he quickly took flight, hopping hurriedly along the seaside track towards Shorncliffe.

Witness accounts indicate that the young 'roo encountered a dog on the path that chased him up the cliff and into Beatham Street, where he sought refuge in the backyard of a residential property. Here a Great Dane who occupied the property confronted him.

It was around this time that Emergency Services and the RSPCA Rescue team intervened to assist the kangaroo. "He was moved from there and relocated to Tinchi Tamba," Therese tells us. The release into the wetlands went well

"Hopefully by now he's been accepted into one of the local mobs, and it's happy days!" Therese said.

## Funds set to boost facilities for Sandgate Hawks

Australian rules football club the Sandgate Hawks has secured \$650,000 in funding to upgrade the club's facilities at Lemke Road, with a firm focus on improving access for all ages and genders.

Hawks Sporting Club President Aaron Widt says the club has welcomed new women's teams and welcomed the upgrade to ensure the facilities are accessible to everyone.

"The existing facilities were built by Hawks volunteers in the 1970s and catered for men's teams," he says.

"The club has welcomed a senior women's team and girls' teams across junior grades as well as Bears softball players, and several other community groups so the existing facility simply didn't cater adequately for all playing participants."

Aaron says the funding will drastically improve the club's offering for the community, with the project providing separate lockable showers and unisex toilet cubicles with a full re-fit to existing change facilities, making them work for the overwhelming increase in female athletes using the venue.

The funding was made available as part of the Queensland Government Female Facilities Program, Brisbane City Council's Building Stronger Communities Program, and with support from AFL Queensland.



# Council Budget A 'Mixed Bag' For Sandgate: Cassidy

eagon Ward Brisbane City Councillor Jared Cassidy has described the latest budget handed down by the Lord Mayor as a "mixed bag" for the Sandgate region.

"Some of the items that I have advocated for on behalf of the community have been funded, like a record number of road resurfacing projects and for the continued funding of the Sandgate Pool upgrade and intersection upgrades along Zillmere Road," Cr Cassidy says.

"The biggest concern I have is that major projects like the Brighton Foreshore have been delayed because of projects like the upgrade of Kingsford Smith Drive."

Lord Mayor Graham Quirk put the Brighton Foreshore upgrade on hold after the 2011 Brisbane floods decimated parts of the city, but Cr Cassidy says those funds we reimbursed from Federal and State sources a few years ago, leaving the Lord Mayor with no reason to delay the upgrade.

So what will it take to for the funds to reach Brighton?

"I wish I knew," Cr Cassidy says.

"I have discussed these projects at great length and in great detail in Council. They have also formed the basis of my budget submission to the Lord Mayor for the past few years now. So the Lord Mayor is more than aware of the importance of these projects."



But Cr Cassidy says there is also a lot of good news for bayside residents.

"This year we have seen the highest number of roads resurfaced in the Deagon Ward," he says.

"This has been important to me with so many older roads in our local area. I was very disappointed that more funding wasn't allocated to rat-running projects — particularly in Boondall and Brighton.

There have been some important projects we have secured funding for like the new Boondall Wetlands Environment Centre, Sandgate Pool upgrade and lighting upgrades at Curlew Park."

As for future budgets, the Councillor has his sights set on more transport-friendly options.

"We need to make all areas of our city more cycle and walking friendly. Sandgate is a great example of where this could occur," he says.

"We already have a lot of people that travel here for our great cycling - can you think of a better place than the foreshore to cycle along? But much more can be done."





# TOP 5 TIPS TO GET THE BEST RESULTS FROM YOUR HEARING AID

1 Keep your Hearing Aid Clean and Dry Daily

For the hearing aid to function properly, there must be no obstruction in the sound input (microphone) or in the sound outlet. Very often an obstruction is caused by earwax or moisture issues. Pay attention to the microphone, wax filter, the earhook and the earmould tubing. These are the common places where a blockage can occur.

2 Battery Supplies

In order to ensure that the hearing aid receives the necessary electric energy, a good quality battery is a must. All new batteries should be kept separately. New batteries should never be in direct contact with another battery or other metal parts. At Sandgate Hearing we stock keyring size battery testers for checking your battery's condition.

Free of Earwax Blockages

As you wear your hearing aid daily, you may be unaware of earwax slowly building up inside your ear. Your ear canal size can change as you age and from years of wearing a hearing aid. This change can affect your hearing aid's efficiency with its fitting becoming loose, and in some cases causing hearing aid whistle. See an audiologist or doctor to inspect your ears regularly. We also provide earwax removal.

Book to See your Audiologist Regularly

Our hearing naturally deteriorates over time. Hearing aids are electronic devices and their performance will slowly deteriorate too. It is important to see your audiologist at least once a year to check your hearing aid and make adjustments to suit your hearing needs.

5 Hearing and Understanding are Different

Hearing aids using factory settings allow you to detect/hear the sounds. Being able to understand the meaning of the information carried by the sounds (speech) is very different. Unlike eyeglasses, which, when put on provide immediate, positive results, hearing loss affects at least five different dimensions of sound receptions. In addition, auditory memory and central cognitive function play a role in speech understanding.

An experienced audiologist can help you find the best possible hearing system and program your hearing aid to the best possible settings for maximum benefits.

If you have been wearing your hearing aid for a while but you're still unsatisfied with the results, see an audiologist and explain how you feel.
