Sandgate Goes The Full Monty

The Full Monty is a raucous, pop-rock-musical that takes it all off, and it's coming to Sandgate Theatre this month.

Director, Lilian Harrington, said the musical was set in Buffalo, New York, but was "essentially the same story as the classic English film version, which became so popular".

"The story is about a group of out of work mill workers who are inspired, by a troupe of out of town strippers, to put on a one-night-only strip show, as a means of earning some much needed money to help their families and pay their bills," Lilian said.

The musical version of the cult film is an international, multi-award winning show. Its popularity comes from the show's engaging melodies and the highly anticipated closing number of the show.

Besides being a lot of fun, Lilian believes the show also has an important message.

"The musical highlights issues about male pride, attitudes, values and beliefs in a working-class community.

"It also highlights the needs of those down on their luck, helping those in need, as well as encouraging them to help themselves; while at the same time the men have to address some embarrassing and personal issues, which they must overcome in order to get the desired outcome from their own show."

Lilian has found some dedicated local talent to bring this show to life.

"I have no doubt that the public will enjoy the cast's energy, sense of fun and jocularly."

There are many songs that will be familiar for the audience, including 'It's a Woman's World', 'Let it Go', 'He's Got the Goods', and one of the director's favourites 'Walk with Me'. There are also some funky dance routines created by Fay Richards. Vocals from Jane Louise Turner and music from Trish Kiessler are sure to create a wonderful vibe for the show.

Sandgate Residents, Let Us *Rejoice*

The local area Australia Day Honours awards are coming to Sandgate for the first time in 2020. Federal member for Lilley, Anika Wells, said the Lilley Honours would be awarded immediately after the annual citizenship ceremony, conducted by Deagon Ward councillor, Jared Cassidy, on Australia Day.

"I felt that we could make the Lilley Honours List a great way to focus on fostering more active citizens and recognising the people stepping up and pitching in," she said.

"As I met community groups on the campaign trail, and in my travels since, I heard the same thing over and over – everyone feels time poor and their resources are stretched," she said.

"People are worried about the declining rates of volunteers and worry about how their organisations will continue.

"I see this as the perfect way to recognise and celebrate local, active citizenship, at the same time as we welcome Sandgate's newest citizens."

The Lilley award winners will still be chosen by a committee of "active and dedicated" local citizens.

"This year we have decided to honour people by celebrating volunteers for the different ways they have served the community," Ms Wells said.

Australia Day by the Bay festivities will still be run by Cr Cassidy and Sandgate MP Stirling Hinchliffe, but in 2020, the celebrations will be moved to later in the afternoon to avoid the heat of the day.

The celebrations will include a free community barbecue, water activities, children's entertainment and music.

"I hope to be able to honour the spirit of the Lilley Honours in Sandgate, as well as being able to focus on fostering volunteers in our wonderful community," Ms Wells said.

1950s' Artefacts

Unearthed at Shorncliffe Station

Queensland Rail project workers have been transported back in time, with hundreds of objects uncovered in the subfloor of Shorncliffe train station.

The heritage items, including train tickets, clothing, newspapers, and milk bottles dating back to the 1950s, were found during investigations of the 1912 station building, ahead of a major restoration program.

Member for Sandgate, Stirling Hinchliffe, said the items were an exciting find for the project team, painting a nostalgic picture of life in the 1950s in Queensland.

"More than 400 items have been unearthed from the subfloor of Shorncliffe station, from train tickets, newspapers and 1950s bottles, to a gas lamp, watering can and clothing," Mr Hinchliffe said.

When the project team started investigations into the structure of the building, to help inform their scope of works, they certainly didn't expect to uncover a piece of history themselves.

"This collection of items provides an interesting glimpse into Shorncliffe's local history, with many of the items, including cordial and milk bottles, coming from local Brisbane factories during that era.

"Many of the artefacts were found wrapped in newspapers, which has served as a time capsule to keep many of the items in good condition. Whether or not that was the intent at the time, we'll never be sure.

Minister Hinchliffe said Queensland Rail planned to showcase the items to the public in the near future.

"I look forward to seeing what other connections our community may find to the pieces," he said.

"Once the items were found by Queensland Rail workers, during the preliminary site investigations, specialist consultants, Niche Environment and Heritage, were engaged to assist Queensland Rail to safely remove the items from the subfloor and catalogue them.

"Ensuring these items are addressed with care is extremely important and Queensland Rail

is continuing to work with the consultants to determine the items' historical value and ensure they're appropriately preserved."

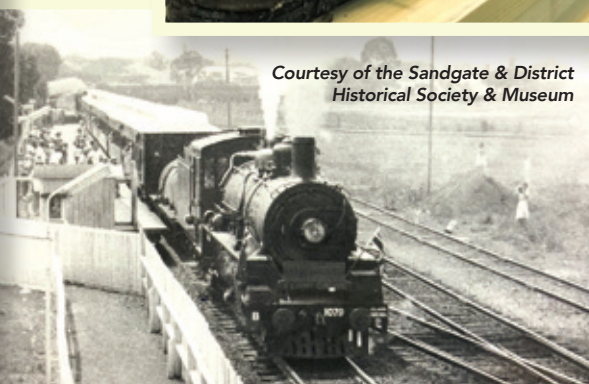
Mr Hinchliffe said that in addition to the historical items, Queensland Rail had unfortunately also found unexpected structural issues with the station building, which will need to be addressed as part of the restoration project.

"This project will require significant repairs to the station building's foundations and walls, as well as replacing the roof, cleaning and painting surfaces, and restoring the air raid shelter.

"The project also included the construction of a new staff facility for our train crew, which was completed last October.

"The temporary ticket office and new platform access to the west of the station building will remain in place while the restoration works continue.

"We're committed to continuing to engage with the community about the restoration project and look forward to providing an update on the final scope and timing of works once Queensland Rail's final investigations are complete."

WE WILL REMEMBER THEM

Remembrance Day is a reminder of the bravery of those who fought for the freedom we are lucky enough to enjoy and an opportunity for Bayside locals to remember them.

The 11th November 1918, at 11am signified the end of the Great War but over the years it has also become a day of remembrance for all who served our country.

As we approach this year's local Remembrance Day service, the Sandgate RSL wants to highlight its ongoing campaign to have a name added to the Sandgate cenotaph.

President of the Sandgate RSL Sub-branch, Peter McNamara, and his team, have been lobbying Brisbane City Council to include Corporal Vincent Healy's name on the local cenotaph.

"Vince, who grew up in a big family in Sandgate, joined the army in November 1944, during WW2 and served till the end of the war, training and preparing for deployment on active service," Mr McNamara said.

"With the end of the war, Vince was selected to continue serving and was deployed as part of the British Commonwealth occupation forces in Japan."

"From there, he was deployed to Korea. Whilst serving with 3 RAR, Vince was tragically

killed in action, on 7 March 1951. The loss was devastating to his mother and siblings."

Vince was awarded several honours and awards, including Australian service medals, the United Nations Service Medal, the Korea Medal and the Australian Defence Medal.

Vince Healy and his story are featured in a book, "Passage to Pusan" written by Vince's niece, Louise Evans, and it is just one of many we are being asked to remember this month.

The Sandgate Remembrance Day activities will begin with a parade at 10.15am, starting from the RSL. The parade will feature the drum corps from the St John Fisher College Band and a police escort.

The Remembrance Day service will follow at 10.45am.

MAN UP AND SHARE YOUR FEELINGS

Men of the 4017 area are being asked to man up – but not like they used to be.

Instead, men are being encouraged to man up by sharing their feelings and changing the way they deal with their mental health.

Katie Dempster, founder of parenting and mental health organisation, I Am Enough, is hosting a Blokes' Barefoot Bowls event, with the aim of getting men to open up.

"I have created events, recently, to give people space to work on their mental health and it was mainly women who attended," Katie said.

"And of the men who did attend, it was their wives who bought the tickets. I just realised that men weren't engaging.

"I spoke to my teenage son, recently, about mental health and I said 'how do men deal with this?' And he replied, 'oh Mum, men don't cry'."

The Blokes' Barefoot Bowls event will be held at the Brighton Health Campus and will feature a day of lawn bowls, a smoked-meat barbecue lunch and a talk from resilience coach, Ryan Easton.

Katie said she came up with the idea for the event after speaking to the men in her life about mental health issues, and she asked them what it would take for them to attend an event and simply talk.

"They pretty much all said sport, a barbecue and alcohol," she said.

"The alcohol bit can be problematic, but the Brighton Hotel is supplying all our attendees with a \$10 voucher, so at the end of the afternoon they can go up to the pub and have a beer.

"A lot of men feel a bit lost; they feel they have lost their place in society and although the discussion around mental health has changed – it's not as taboo anymore – this still needs to be addressed."

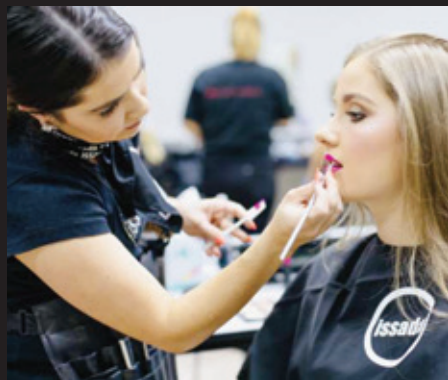

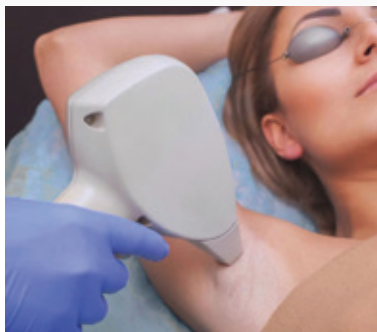

Smart Poles, The Way To The Future

The Brisbane City Council recently announced that it is installing 20 smart poles across Brisbane, with the Sandgate foreshore, near the Sandgate Aquatic Centre, and Bracken Ridge Skate Plaza, as two of the proposed locations.

Council said the smart poles will house a range of location-specific sensors and devices to collect information, which will help them make decisions on what essential services should be delivered for residents and visitors.

The seven-meter tall poles will look similar to the current light poles and will collect and send real-time data back to council.

Councils said features of the smart pole include, but are not limited to; beacon LEDs, creative lighting, pedestrian and cyclist detection, climate and air quality monitoring, free public Wi-Fi and USB charging ports.

The smart poles are expected to be installed by late-2019, and fully operational by mid-2020.

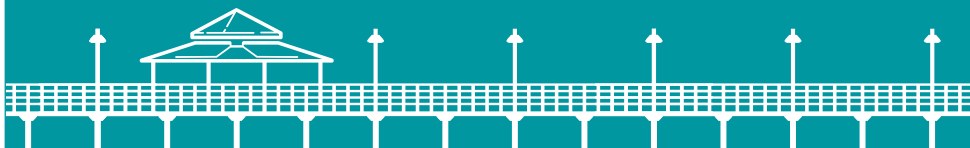

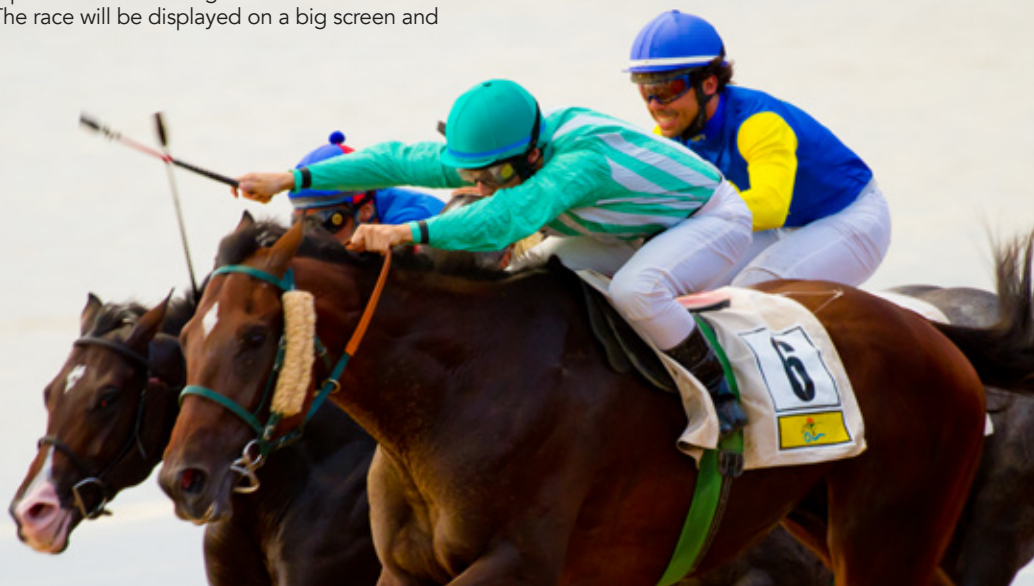

A Twist on Tradition

In 1956, Filippo Follari barely had a hair on his chin, yet he could give a clean shave to anyone who walked into the barbershop.

Little did he know, this skill would take him from Italy to Australia and inspire the next generation of barbers.

These days, Filippo works at Felice's Barbershop, run by his son in Sandgate, where the tradition continues.

Felice Follari said he could not imagine what those days must have been like for his dad. "Back then, school was not much of an option," he said.

"In Italy, he just walked past a barbershop and thought he'd like to do that. In Grade 4 he started his apprenticeship. A 12-year-old doing

a face shave; it's incredible to think he could do that."

Felice said he was much older when he finished his own training, and came to the area in 2001. "My dad scouted the shop out in Sandgate when I was finishing my apprenticeship," he said.

"He took me for a drive here and I thought – really, it was an old area back then.

"The old barber was selling his shop; it was probably here 30 years before me.

"It was a one chair barbershop, now we have five and it's been going really well over the years.

"We've seen a few changes in the area; more young families and people are moving to the area; the demographic is changing and there's lots of different shops.

"Although, the older generation is still our bread and butter.

"I have customers coming in and I've cut their father's hair and their kid's hair."

Sandgate has changed over the years, along with hairstyles, but Felice said some things stay the same and good staff were key.

"Not everyone gets to work with their dad," Felice said. "He still helps me a few days a week; he's 75 years old. I have other long-term staff and our customers like seeing familiar faces."

The barbers do mens and children's haircuts, plus face shaves and beard trims.

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN LIFE AND DEATH

One Brighton family went through a traumatic experience earlier this year, and it's prompted them to organise a free CPR first aid training event with local organisation, My First Aid Course.

Aaron Harper-Giles, his wife Deborah and their children, were on holidays on the Gold Coast in January, when a toddler was pulled from the pool of the resort where they were staying.

"I just heard Deb yell out in an absolute panic, 'Aaron, first aid!'," Mr Harper-Giles said.



I ran around the pool and got to the toddler; this little boy was about 2-years-old. His mum was really in hysterics, saying 'he's not breathing'."

Mr Harper-Giles had recently completed a first aid refresher course. "This little guy was grey; he was so pallid," he said.

"I started CPR, breaths and compressions, and all of a sudden he just brought up a heap of water.

"He was breathing again, but it was very raspy and we just monitored him until the ambulance came.

"It would have been only five minutes before the ambulance got there, but it was the longest five minutes of my life."

Mrs Harper-Giles also helped during the emergency and their children kept the young victim's family calm. Fortunately, the toddler made a full recovery.

"We're just so thankful that we were there and we knew what to do," Mr Harper-Giles said.

The event has prompted the family to arrange free CPR training for the 4017 community.

"It's a hands-on course, there's no certificate at the end of it, but it's a proper training course," Mr Harper-Giles said.

"And it's for kids as well – if they're old enough to listen, they're old enough to come along.

"My First Aid Course has very kindly agreed to run it for free."

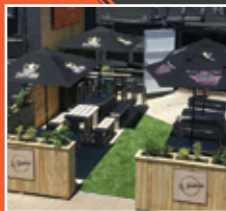

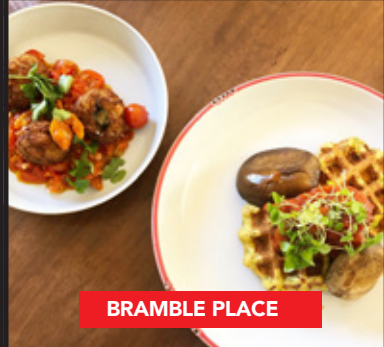

A Year of Achievements for Green P

The Green P community farm at Deagon Racecourse has gone from strength to strength over the past 12 months.

SANDBAG community partnership worker, Keira Brett, said the farm had experienced an amazing year.

"The community farm is a place where communication and cultural barriers are broken down, with participants from all community groups working together to ensure the farm is a vibrant, peaceful and productive space," Keira said.

"The farm has over 130 participants with more than 75% hailing from a refugee or new arrival background. The project currently has a waiting list of farm participants and volunteers who wish to become involved. We've had a 37% increase in sign-ups to the farm in comparison with this time last year!"

Late last year, the initiative won the Litter Prevention Group Award in Brisbane City Council's Cleaner Suburbs awards, for working with local businesses to divert 150 - 200kg of food waste from landfill per week.

This year the farm was featured on an episode of Gardening Australia.

With summer just around the corner, it's time to search for somewhere to swim!

Whether you're the type to dip your toe in first, or one to take the plunge, when the weather gets hot there are many places to swim and cool off, just a short drive away.

Besides the local options such as Settlement Cove Lagoon and the newly refurbished Sandgate Aquatic Centre, a little further afield you'll find beautiful places such as Cedar Creek, near Samford, and the numerous waterfalls and swimming holes on the Sunshine Coast Hinterland.

As you climb the mountain, you feel the mercury fall by a few degrees, and the water at places like Kondalilla Falls and Gardner's Falls – both not far from Maleny – or Serenity Falls near Buderim, are refreshingly cool.

Kondalilla means running water in the local Gubbi Gubbi language, and there's plenty there.

You can enjoy the beautiful rockpool at the top of the main waterfall or take the 40-60 minute walk via the bottom of the falls. At nearby Gardner's Falls, try dipping into the gently flowing waters of Obi Obi Creek, just a short stroll from the end of Obi Obi Road. There are rope swings for big and little kids and room to relax in the shade of tall trees. Serenity Falls swimming hole, in Buderim Forest Park, is an oasis for the warmer months. Set in sub-tropical rainforest, the falls are a 350m walk from the parking area, picnic tables, and barbecues, and are just a short 15-minute drive from Buderim township.

Sometimes, in the summer months, we need a dose of salt water too; so, for surf beaches try Bribie Island or anywhere on the Sunshine Coast. From Caloundra to Noosa there are several glorious beaches with lots of areas flagged for safe swimming and overseen by lifeguards. Perfect for a day trip!

Wherever you go when you need to cool off this summer, remember to be safe, and enjoy the wonderful water we're so lucky to have nearby!

One of the biggest and best junior squash events on the calendar is on again, with significant prize vouchers up for grabs.

Nathan Turnbull said the junior tournament was open to any junior squash players, not just members of Sandgate Squash.

"We have juniors from all over Australia enter in previous years and even had some international juniors fly over from New Zealand last year to compete," Nathan said.

The centre boasts five traditional hard courts and one championship glass-back court and can accommodate viewing for up to 100 people. So head along and check them out.

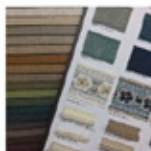

FISH OF THE MONTH

Yellowtail Kingfish *Seriola lalandi*

A favourite of mine, at this time of year, and great eating quality too, is the Yellowtail Kingfish. If you have a boat and can get across to Moreton Island, they can be found at Curtin Artificial Reef and around Tangalooma. Live bait is the key to catching them; Yellowtail Pike work best, although large Herring and Yakka are also good. Many of the shipping markers hold bait, which is easy to catch using standard bait jigs.

Kingfish pull very hard and will cut you off, as soon as they can get near any structure. They are often responsible for comments like, "I'm sure I just hooked a freight train" or words we can't actually print here. They have left many an angler with trembling hands and a look on their face of wonder at what just happened. It is not uncommon for us to catch fish that already

have other hooks in their mouth that they have busted off other anglers.

Good-sized fish around here are between 10kg and 25kg, but they can grow to over 50kg. I rate them as four out of five to eat, but they must be iced immediately, as with most fish.

I have recently made some videos on YouTube with some of these fish actually eating livebait that has been placed in front of the camera underwater. They're great to watch and it's amazing what they can fit in their mouths. There are also some older fishing videos you can find by searching "Tangalooma Kingfish" and "How to catch Pike for Livebait."
