

#### LOCAL MUM MASTERS 1600KM UK BIKE RIDE

Prighton resident and mother of three, Heidi Degen, recently ventured out of her comfort zone to embark on a life-changing journey.

In June last year, she set out on a 14-day bike ride across the United Kingdom, covering a distance of 1600 kilometres.

Heidi said she had been planning the adventure for years but it wasn't until a conversation with a friend that she finally took the plunge.

"I commented to a friend that I'd really love to do the ride and she simply said, 'Why don't

you?'," Heidi said. "And so I phoned England, booked my spot on the supported group tour and that was the beginning of one of the best things I've ever done."

The ride, known as LEJOG (Land's End to John O'Groats) took Heidi from the southernmost point of mainland Britain to the almost northernmost point.

"I had 14 days of sunshine and absolutely perfect weather conditions – absolutely unheard of for the UK," Heidi said. "The scenery was out of this world spectacular.

"The joy of cruising down a massive hill hitting 70 to 80 kilometres an hour occasionally definitely was a buzz, if not a little stupid for an amateur.

"There were multiple 130-kilometre days with really high elevation and having to ride day after day was a real challenge as I'd never done a multi-day ride before."

Heidi said it was hard being away from her family.

"One day I was having a really big wobble of self-confidence and my 12-year-old daughter said simply to me on the phone, 'Like you say to me mum, you just need to keep going, picture the end in your mind, the pain will be over soon and you'll be so proud," she said. "To hear her repeat back one of life's greatest lessons really made me feel like I had accomplished something good with her."

When Heidi finally completed her journey, she took to Facebook to share her thoughts.

"I'm beyond grateful for a trip that has exceeded my expectations and has given me the gift of self-love like I've never experienced before," she wrote. "A love and appreciation for myself that runs really, really deep."

Heidi said the mental aspect of the ride far outweighed the physical challenge.

"The mind is incredibly powerful," she said.
"Through perseverance and belief that if you can, anything is really possible."



# PSDCAST OF THE MONTH

#### **Linda Sings Again**

Earshot tells intimate stories exploring the human experience and is produced by Linda's long-time friend, Claudia Taranto. In the latest and last episode of the series, Linda opens up about her life-changing treatment for Parkinson's Disease (PD).

Linda said she was keen to share her story after learning many people were unaware of Deep Brain Stimulation (DBS), a surgical procedure involving the implantation of electrodes in the brain.

"There is a multiplicity of stories in the podcast," Linda said. "The story of a woman with PD, of her family and how they care for her, the story of the power of music, the story of incredible leaps in medicine, and of relationships of care and respect across generations."

Titled Return of the Songbird, the episode features original songs composed and played by Linda and her musical collaborator, local performer Dublin Rose.

Claudia, who has been creating audio features for ABC for 30 years, said her aim in Return of the Songbird was to capture Linda's boundless creativity, her beautiful relationship with Dublin, the story of her family's support, and the benefits DBS has had on her life.

"I'm very happy with the result," Claudia said. "Dublin and Linda's singing is sublime, as is Linda's writing and honesty about living with Parkinson's Disease.

"The beautiful harmonising of Linda and Dublin's voices when they sing the songs they've written together brings a lightness to the story but also an emotional depth.

"In podcasts, the words speak to our brains but the music speaks to our hearts. I've learned that from Linda."

The podcast also includes interviews with Linda's sister Cathie, brother Paul, filmmaker Bella Lightfoot, and the Professor of Clinical Neuroscience at the Queensland Brain Institute and Director of Neurosciences Queensland, Peter Silburn, who explains Linda's DBS surgery.

Since having the surgery in November 2022, Linda said she can now play board games, write songs, make photographic art, joke with friends, read books, enjoy TV shows, swim, and ride her bike.

"There aren't many situations in life where you can honestly say your life changed almost instantaneously like a miracle," Linda said.

"At the same time comes the awareness that I am not cured of Parkinson's Disease and that I will still face many challenges. But what DBS really gave me was time. Now I am not a slave to the medication cycle."

Linda has also returned to playing the violin, which she stopped after her diagnosis in 2013. Last year, Linda and Dublin held a house concert where they performed original songs for family and friends.

"This was a major milestone I never thought I would reach," Linda said. "But there I was singing and strumming a little. The songbird really had returned."



our local bowls club is back and there's lots on offer for the community to enjoy.

Last month, the Sandgate Bowls Club reopened as The Sands Bowlo, the newest club for The Sands Social.

Membership will work across both venues, as both are owned and operated by Kedron-Wavell.

Kedron-Wavell Chief Executive Officer Lyndon Broome said they decided to take on the management of the Sandgate Bowls Club after learning it was on the verge of closure.

"As our neighbour, we were looking at an amazing 109-year history of who they are and where they've been and we didn't want that history to disappear from Sandgate," Lyndon said.

"Our view was that we would manage the club and let them keep bowling and continue their 109-year history. They are our neighbours and we want to see the best for them."

A Sandgate Bowls Club member said the club had been an integral part of the community for more than 100 years, but had been dependent on volunteers to manage bowls and fundraising activities.

"It has been increasingly difficult over the last five years or so to sustain that effort," the member said. "Members agreed to the relationship with Kedron-Wavell as the best way to sustain bowls at the venue and to ensure its value as a hospitality provider for the benefit of the Sandgate community.

"The overall members' opinion would appear to be that they are delighted that the purposes for which the bowls club was initiated in 1914 can now continue through the good offices of Kedron-Wayell."

The club had been closed since May 2023 due to renovations carried out by Brisbane City Council to improve equitable access, including new pathways, ramps, parking, stairs, and disabled toilets. The venue has also been upgraded with new carpeting, tiles, and a general freshen-up.

Lyndon said The Sands Bowlo would focus on community engagement.

"We want to activate that green space for as many activities as we can," he said. "Low impact sports for seniors, movie nights, event weekends. We've had success with food trucks in the past for special weekend events. Barefoot bowls will be a big anchor as well and we want to engage school groups to be involved with bowling."

The venue officially opened with a celebration over the Australia Day long weekend.

he Brighton Hotel is starting 2024 with a major glow-up.

The iconic suburban pub is currently under renovation, with big plans for the year ahead.

Australian Venue Co brand marketing manager, Pippa Finks, spoke to the Sandgate Guide about the exciting changes.

"It's going to be light and bright, with a very coastal and modern look," Pippa said.

"One of the biggest changes is that we're adding a huge outdoor area at the front.

"There will be a lovely big beer garden space right across the front area, with two separate entrances leading into the new sports bar and new bistro areas.

"We're also installing a kid's playground, which will be nice and shaded."

Pippa added the old Charlie's Bistro was also being rebranded.

"We've got a new menu in the works, keeping some of the locals' favourite dishes, and introducing a bunch of new items as well – expect lots of classic Queensland pub food, with fresh local seafood," she said.

"We are very mindful of the cost of living right now, and we are going to be offering some pretty amazing weekly specials.

"We're also going to be offering a pretty comprehensive entertainment program as well. There will be lots of live music, trivia, bingo – you name it."

The hotel's popular Tradie Club will continue to operate, with great specials and deals on Fridays for local tradies, including a free weekly barbecue.

The new gaming room is already up and running, and the Brighton Hotel's accommodation will also be getting a makeover.

"We're so excited to be part of the area, particularly with the upgrades to the Brighton foreshore, it's so lovely," Pippa said.

"We're very keen to bring the Brighton Hotel up to speed with other local venues."

The renovations at the Brighton Terrace venue should be complete by late April.

The singer, songwriter and guitarist has been selected as a finalist in Brisbane City Council's The QUBE Effect 2024.

Dublin said she was extremely excited to be one of the 20 finalists and hoped to use the opportunity to establish herself in the Brisbane music scene.

"I'm so grateful to be given the opportunity to showcase my music to a broader audience," she said. "It is also such an amazing networking opportunity.

"I am also extremely excited for the live performances as I love being on stage and playing with the band."

As part of The QUBE Effect, Dublin will have mentorship opportunities with music industry professionals and film a music video for her original song, There You Go Again.

"It's a fun song that my band and I rock out to and I hope it will appeal to a wide audience," she said. "It is about being lost in the daydream of young love.

"Some 4017 locals might even know this song, as I have played it at many local events and recently at the Sandgate Youth Festival.

"Soon we will be allocated a team, including a director and producer to coordinate the music video, which will be filmed in February and released in April."

Dublin will also perform on stage with the other finalists at The QUBE Effect Live Event during Brisbane Youth Week in April.

Past winners of The QUBE Effect have gone on to achieve record deals and festival billing.

"I dream of becoming an established touring artist and recognised songwriter," Dublin said.

"I have written over 65 completed songs, many of which I hope to record in the near future.

"I am constantly composing and love developing my craft, experimenting with different styles, chords, and instruments. I am eager to release more music and have so far had a wonderful response to my original songs, which I am grateful for."



Ithough I can't promise you groupies and TVs propelled out of windows, the documentary 'Welcome to the Darkness' is probably as close as most of us will ever come to being Rock Gods.

Hop on the tour bus with legendary Brit rockers The Darkness, who shot to fame in the early 2000s – selling millions of albums, packing out stadiums across the world and lining their shelves with awards. Now, we join them as they start their comeback tour.

You may know them from anthems such as I Believe in a Thing Called Love and Love Is Only a Feeling, to name but a few. Not ringing a bell? No worries, an insightful backstory is provided for the uninitiated.

The proposed food and drink outlet will provide a gross floor area of 193.9 square metres, including indoor dining and a drive-through facility that can accommodate up to 10 vehicles.

The development also includes onsite parking for 13 vehicles, as well as adequate vehicle and pedestrian access.

Operating hours for the new Starbucks Cafe would be Monday to Sunday, 24/7. According to the planners at Somerville Consultants, the development has been designed to meet the commercial needs of the area while minimising any adverse effects on surrounding properties.

"The site is considered an ideal location for increased commercial development," a spokesperson at Somerville Consultants said.

"The proposed structure is deliberately located towards the centre of the site to maximise pedestrian and vehicular safety while minimising any potential unfavourable amenity and noise impacts on the nearby sensitive uses.

In addition to the considerable setbacks, building separation and landscaping, the development maintains (a) low level of amenity and noise on the nearby residential uses."

#### **METHOD**

# Development lodged for Sandgate Ambulance Station

development application has been submitted for the construction of the Sandgate Ambulance Station, located at 99 Hoyland Street, Bracken Ridge. The site, which is currently vacant with no existing structures, will be transformed into a two-storey ambulance station designed by Peddle Thorp.

The development will be carried out in two stages, with a maximum building height of two storeys. Stage 1 will focus on the construction of the ambulance station and plant room.

It will include various facilities such as meeting and training rooms, hot desks, multipurpose rooms, offices, a kitchen, and locker rooms. This stage will also provide parking space for 10 ambulance vehicles.

Stage 2, which will be implemented in the future, aims to expand the accommodation for ambulance operations.

It will include provisions for an additional 50 vehicles and will have a capacity to accommodate 250 staff.

The proposed development will cover an area of 15,804 square metres and will operate 24/7.

Access to the ambulance station will be facilitated by the construction of a new 'signalised hot exit' and left-in left-out main access onto Hoyland Street.

The design of the site intends to blend the new structures with the existing public parkland to the south.

The removal of parts of the acoustic barrier will be replaced with non-solid security fencing, allowing for improved ventilation and increased surveillance of the surrounding areas.

#### FOOTY FUN KICKS OFF AT NUDGEE RECREATION RESERVE

he Nudgee Recreation Reserve, once a former landfill site, has been transformed into a multisports and recreation reserve.

AThe reserve officially opened in December and will be home to Football Queensland's new north Brisbane facilities, which include a playing field, a clubhouse and community spaces.

Football Queensland CEO Robert Cavallucci said the six football fields at the Football Queenslandleased facility were fully booked well in advance of the opening of the reserve.

"The Nudgee Recreation Reserve will deliver valuable field space for a number of local community clubs, providing more opportunity for the community to get involved in our beautiful game in the wake of the hugely successful FIFA Women's World Cup 2023 as we continue working towards our goal of 50/50 gender parity in participation by 2027," he said.

Although the space has been used for sports since 1946, it served as a landfill site in the mid-1970s. Remediation works were carried out by Brisbane City Council to restore the site for sports and active recreation.

In addition to the football fields, the revamped 12.7-hectare reserve includes two soccer fields, two cricket pitches, a BMX pump track, a playground, picnic settings with shelters and barbeque facility, a walking/running/cycling path, and a dog off-leash area.

A new 223-space car park and pathway connects to Nudgee Train Station and Railway Street.

our neighbour's dog barks all day? A cavernous pothole has opened up on your street? Today, complaints of this nature prompt a call to the Brisbane City Council. In the past, though, governance in our area was a more local affair.

Sandgate became a self-governing entity in 1880, the Queenslander reporting in June: "At last Sandgate rejoices in that 'crowning mercy', its constitution into a municipality". The "crowning mercy" of self-governance lasted until 1925 when Sandgate's civic authority was ceded to Greater Brisbane.

The first council meeting took place in 1881. That initial gathering faced a number of immediate problems, such as dangerous ill-repair on the road to Cabbage Tree Creek, but larger issues loomed and, as the aldermen were about to learn, local government cost money.

The first requirement was a workforce to implement their programs. To that end, they appointed a foreman of works, an inspector of nuisances and, in February 1882, a town clerk. In addition, several costly projects demanded their swift attention: construction of council chambers (as an insight into their probable priorities, the first town hall building was completed by 1882); widening Eagle Terrace, and constructing three culverts on Rainbow Street. Financing these and other undertakings required a loan of £1000 from the Queensland government.

Among the day-to-day responsibilities of the council were the supply of water, the health of residents (necessitating payments to a health officer), the disposal of rubbish and the removal of "night soil" from outhouses to the manure depot.

Inevitably, as officials making decisions affecting public amenity and the lives of residents, Sandgate councillors earned their share of opprobrium. Complaints, often voiced via outraged letters to newspapers, included failure to supply drinking water to summer visitors; the "perfunctory manner in which sanitary considerations are regarded" (code for insufficient supply of sawdust to the town's outhouses); and poor street lighting.

One of the strangest controversies to bedevil those early aldermen arose in 1889 from "the action of the council in imprisoning members of the Salvation Army". The pretext for this unfortunate incarceration was the "protection of traffic". A disgruntled "Sandgate Visitor" who penned a protest to the Brisbane Courier, though, believed that the issue was not the startling of horses by the "playing of a noisy instrument in the street" but the council's anti-Salvationist prejudice.

Whatever the truth of that matter, arousing the ire of ratepayers probably goes with a councillor's territory. If nothing else, the council gives us, as it did our forebears, something to complain about.



Cane toad tadpole trapping

he Dowse Lagoon Bushcare group has been busy this summer season, removing around 100,000 tadpoles from Dowse Lagoon and Fourth Lagoon in Deagon Wetlands.

The group has been focusing on reducing the number of cane toads in their vulnerable tadpole phase as part of a tadpole trapping program.

Mike Chamberlain, a volunteer with the Dowse Lagoon Bushcare Group said cane toads were a threat to native wildlife and poisonous to animals who eat them.

"The group meets weekly, restoring the native vegetation and removing weeds, and when we heard about the cane toad tadpole traps we were interested in trying them out, as we see lots of toads around the lagoon," Mike said.

The group uses a humane and effective method, thanks to a discovery made by researchers at the University of Queensland. They found that cane toad tadpoles are attracted to a chemical released by toad eggs. This led the non-profit organisation Watergum to develop the Cane Toad Tadpole Trap and Lure, which specifically targets cane toad tadpoles.

Mike said the community could join with neighbours to purchase traps and lures and monitor water bodies near them.

"Fourth Lagoon in Deagon Wetlands seems to be a breeding hotspot and it would be wonderful if nearby residents would take that one as a project," he said. "We are also asking residents near our lagoons to contact us when they hear male toads calling en masse – we then expect to see many tadpoles a few weeks later."



he North Brisbane Lapidary Club is a haven for those who are interested in adding to a treasure trove of cut gems, jewellery designs and similar handicrafts and participating in related activities.

The Club has existed since 1966 as a not-for-profit organisation offering a space to learn new skills, connect with like-minded people, and gain a broader knowledge of minerals and gemstones.

North Brisbane Lapidary Club Chair, Lewis Shotter, said that a membership also affords the opportunity to take part in exciting fossicking trips and enhanced social activities.

"Activities include faceting, cabbing, silver work, gold work, wire wrapping, enamelling, lost wax casting and fossicking," Mr Shotter said.

Slightly tucked away near the entrance to Albert Bishop Park in Nundah, this 'candy store for jewellery makers' is complete with a display of gemmological and geological materials to rival any museum's collection.

Upon a chat with Mr Gatfield, one is illuminated to the fact that 'lapidary' is, in fact, a very interesting Latin term, "used to refer to the practice of shaping stone, minerals, or gemstones for ornamental purposes, with the ornamental element distinguishing it from related skill sets such as stone masonry."

The club operates from Monday to Saturday and often incorporates new courses for the various activities over the weekend, with joining and annual fees kept to a minimum.

The folks at North Brisbane Lapidary Club are also gearing up for the next annual gem show scheduled for early March, which is set to feature live demonstrations (such as faceting and silversmithing) with displays and sales of gemstones, jewellery, crystals and much more.

#### LAWN GRUB SEASON

Lawn grubs are caterpillars from a small grey moth that eats the green leaf of the lawn and in large numbers can virtually kill the whole lawn if left unchecked. There are many other pests that attack lawns, such as Mealy Bugs, Scarab grubs, Couch Mites, Scale that can cause serious damage, however the Lawn Grub is the main pest here in Brisbane. It costs a lot of money to replace turf these days, so it is a good idea to keep an eye on your lawn for signs of pest invasion.

HERE'S SOME SIGNS TO LOOK OUT FOR:

#### 1. BROWN PATCHES IN YOUR LAWN

Lawn grubs eat the green leaf and leave only the stalk, stripping all the leaf blade bare, thus leaving the lawn brown and thin looking. The lawn will take a long time to recover, and areas might need replacing if it dies right back. The lawn becomes very thin, with no cover to protect the exposed soil, it then dries out and weeds come in, as well the soil starts to repel water as it dries right out in the hot weather.

#### 2. WASP ACTIVITY

If Army Worm are attacking your lawn, you will notice large orange wasps start to hover around your turf. They are looking for the Army Worm & Army Worm Pupa to lay their egg's in.

#### 3. MOTH ACTIVITY

When Army Worm mature they turn into moths, these moths then lay eggs in your turf, under your gutters and in every corner of your property, starting the life cycle starts all over again. If you see lots of moths hovering above your lawn it's likely you have had or will have lawn grubs soon.

#### 4. INCREASED BIRD ACTIVITY ON YOUR LAWN

If birds are pecking at your lawn a lot more lately, it's likely there's some juicy grubs in your turf that they're snacking on.



### e have two species of Saratoga in Australia, the Gulf Saratoga (Scleropages jardinii) and the Queensland Saratoga (Scleropages leichardti).

They are spectacular jumping fighters, which are in my opinion one of the better sportsfish we can catch locally thanks to stocking groups and the SIPS fishing permit scheme. Being freshwater fish, our local dams North Pine and Lake Kurwongbah are now some of the best places to chase these fish in Australia.

Top water lures such as poppers, fake frogs and shallow divers are mainly used, although I have caught them with live shrimp under a float too. Sharp hooks are a must as these fish have very bony mouths and throw hooks easily. Growing to nearly a metre long, most fish I have seen are up to about 60cm.

This prehistoric-looking fish that hasn't changed for millions of years is also a mouth brooder with the female holding the eggs in her mouth and the young staying very close, retreating inside when threatened.

It is also a very valued aquarium fish that takes a lot of room and care, with prices beginning at over \$120 each. They are not generally regarded as a table fish.

### What to do if you have sudden hearing loss

We consider sudden hearing loss at 30 dBH or greater in at least 3 testing frequencies within 72 hours. Sudden hearing loss usually affects only one ear. Bilateral sudden hearing loss is rare. Your history and an examination can identify whether the hearing loss is conductive or sensorineural in nature. Conductive hearing loss includes earwax, trauma, and Otitis Media with effusion. A referral for a hearing test is essential in such cases and our clinic considers these as emergency cases. If the hearing loss has been identified as sensorineural and is potentially reversible, we may recommend an urgent Ear Nose and Throat's specialist (ENT) referral and/or an Emergency Department (ED) visit to Royal Brisbane Women's Hospital (RBWH) where there's access to an ENT and to Hyperbaric



Oxygen Therapy treatment. A delay in treatment may reduce the chance of reversing or reducing permanent hearing loss.
